

# Ryan Saunders and Roger Cundall Win

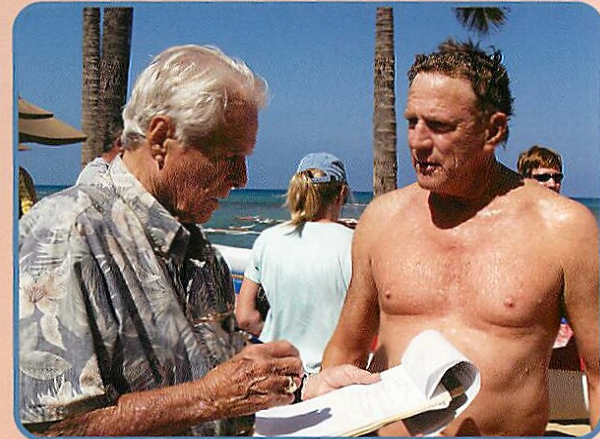


ABOVE: Kristi Torkildson congratulates two-mile swim winner Ryan Saunders.

Hey! What's a little vog, anyway? It was a beautiful Sunday morning on May 18 in spite of the lingering vog, which had been intense and unpleasant for several days.

In spite of the vog, 69 stalwart swimmers signed in that morning to compete in the OCC's Annual Invitational Swim, open only to OCC members and swimmers from other masters programs on Oahu by invitation.

The two-mile course is one-half mile out to the first turn buoy, parallel to the beach to the second turn buoy set off the Kapahulu Groin, reverse course to the first turn buoy and in to the OCC beach. For those over 50, the one-mile swim is straight out the channel to the half mile buoy and return to the OCC beach.

Roger Cundall splashed ashore at 26 minutes 46.3 seconds as winner of the one-mile short course. Betty-Ann Barnett was the female winner of the short course in 26 minutes, 45.1 seconds.

Junior 'Rigger Ryan Saunders won the two-mile swim in 52 minutes, 37.1 seconds while Miki David was the first woman to finish in 55 minutes, 57.3 seconds.

Although no current was perceivable from shore, many swimmers came in exclaiming about the strong Waikiki to Diamond Head current which was running and which caused a number of swimmers to be carried off course.

And for the first time to my knowledge, a Club General Manager grabbed a paddleboard and patrolled the race course from the water. Mahalo to Mike Ako for his kokua.

The OCC Sunday Brunch was enjoyed by all after the swim.

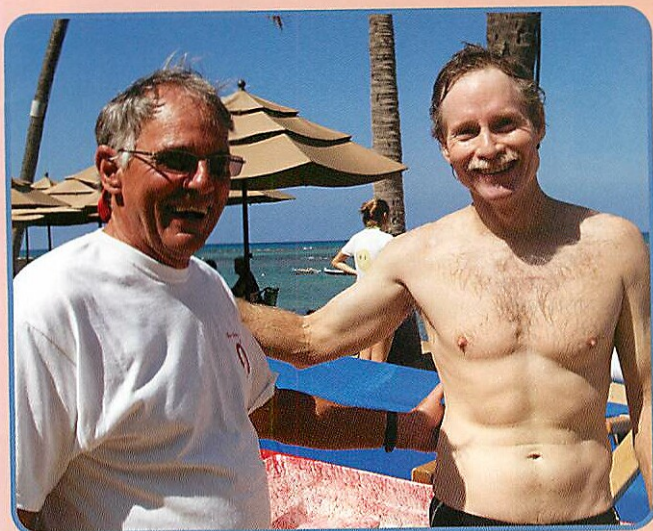
