swimming keeps you young.

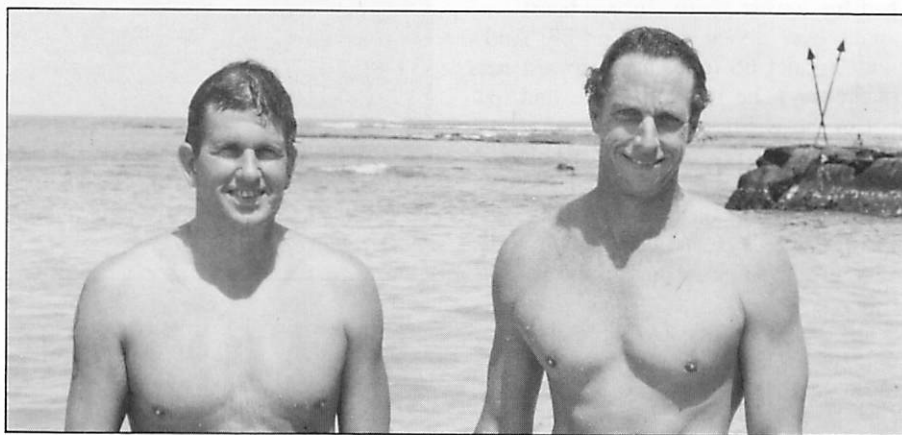
I don't know where all our young swimmers were but the youngest participant was 23 years old.

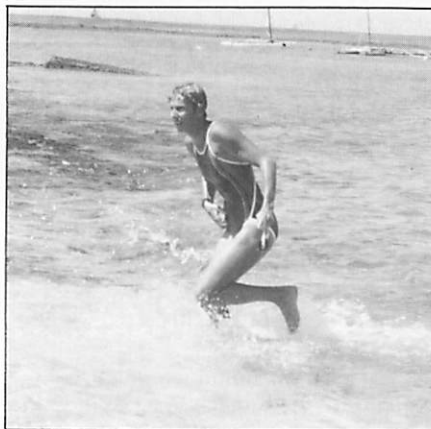

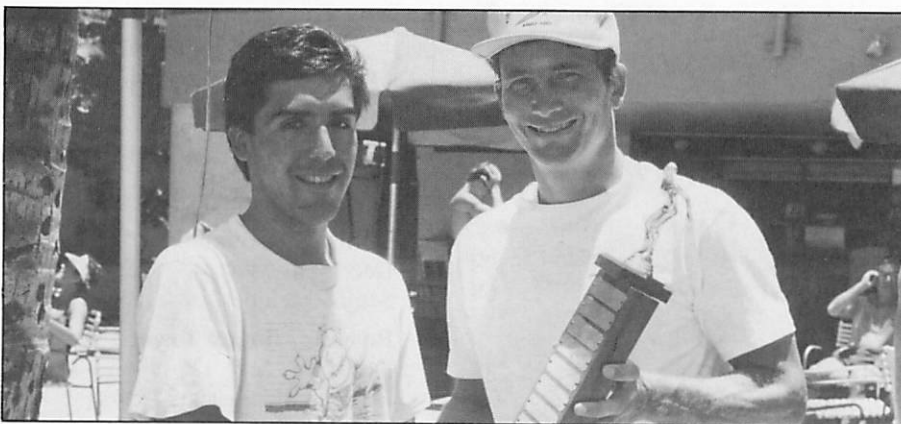
Outrigger's first two finishers were Richard Sylva and Roger Cundall.
