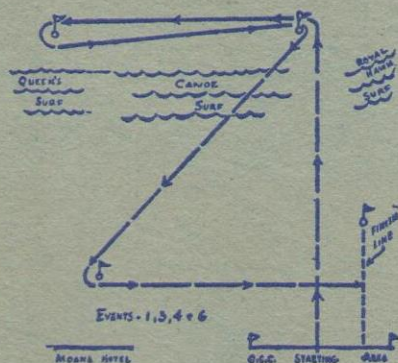

1½ Miles

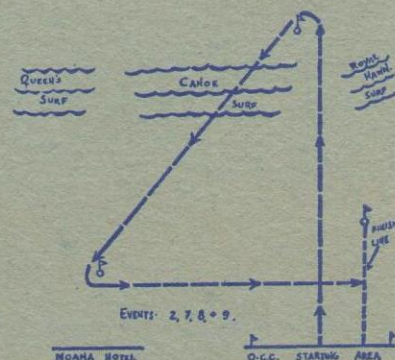
Starting from shore (inside starting area), thence to flag buoy outside canoe surf, leaving it to PORT, thence to flag buoy outside QUEEN SURF, leaving it to PORT, thence returning to flag buoy outside canoe surf, leaving it to STARBOARD, thence to finish line on shore (inside starting area).

½ Mile

Starting from shore (inside starting area) thence out to flag buoy outside canoe surf, leaving it to PORT, thence to finish line on shore (inside starting area).

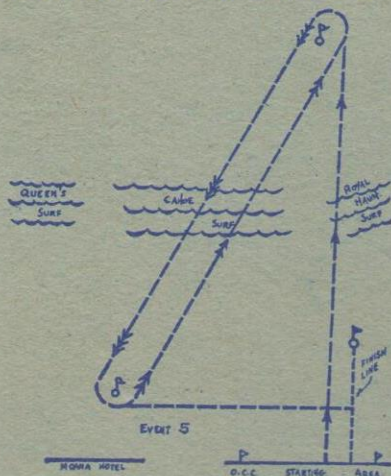

COURSE 3

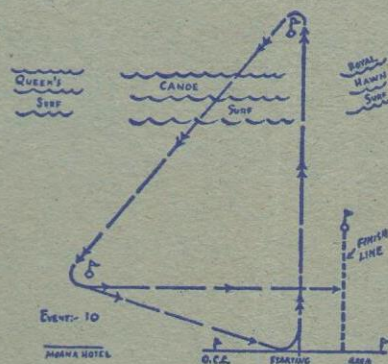
4½ Miles

Starting from shore (inside starting area) thence out to flag buoy near popular surf, leaving it to PORT, thence to flag buoy in shore near MOANA HOTEL, leaving it to PORT, thence twice more around, thence to finish line between Judges' Stand (O.C.C.) and flag buoy off shore (surfing permissible).



COURSE 4

FIRST HALF of the relay must finish on shore with BOW facing the ocean before the second half starts. Failing to do this will be disqualified. SECOND HALF finish on shore with BOW point shoreward O.C.C.
