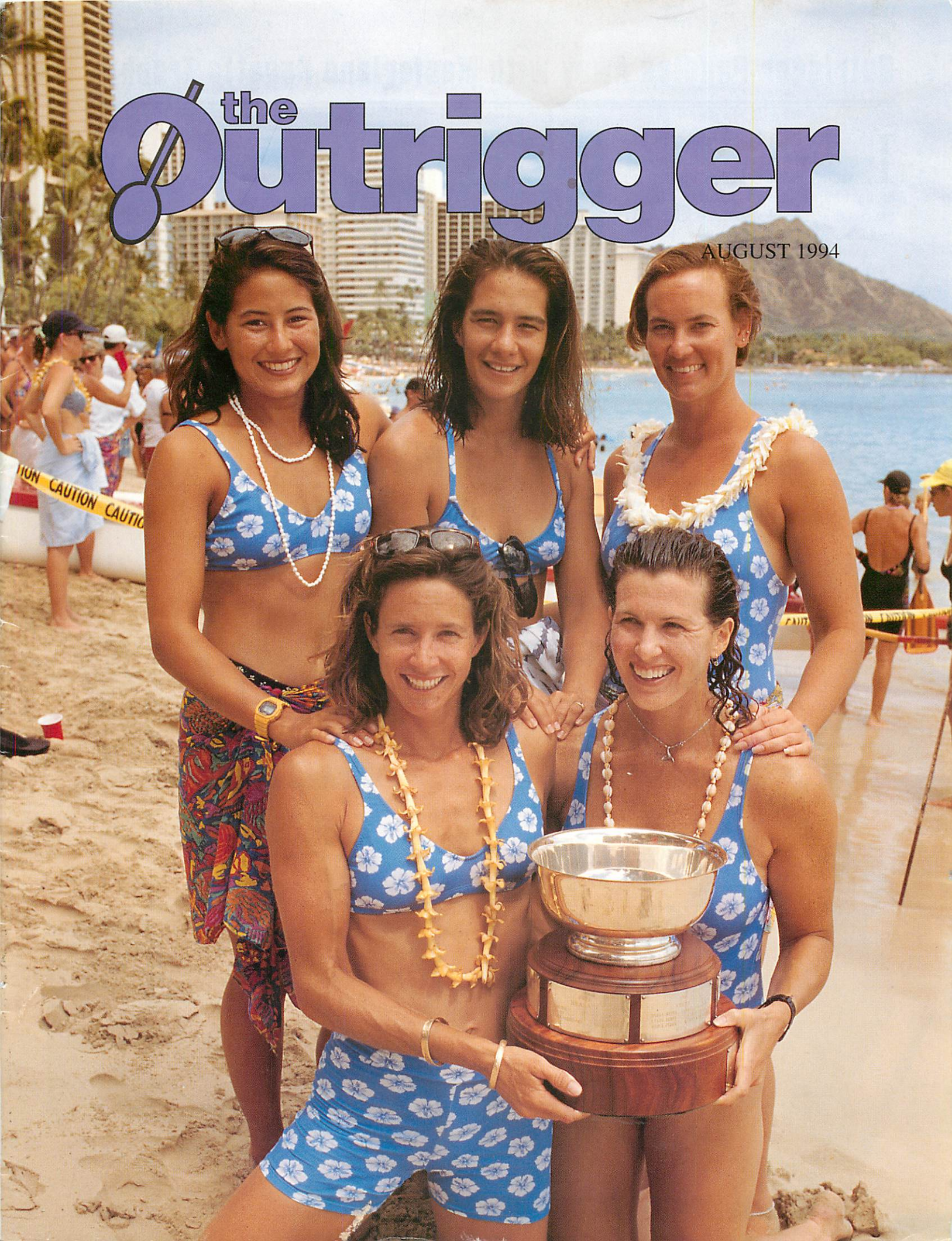

Outrigger Paddles Away with Macfarlane Regatta Trophy

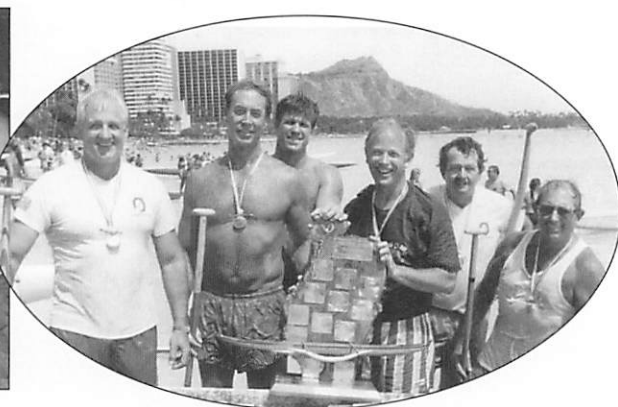

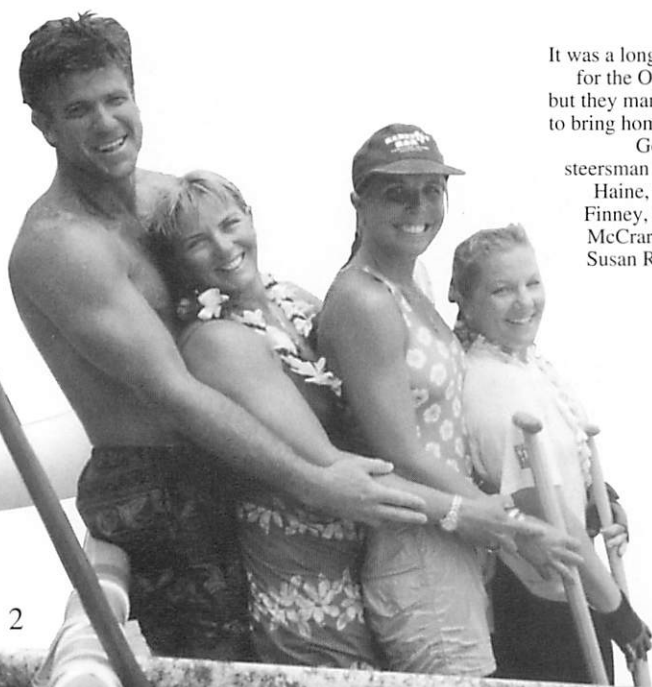

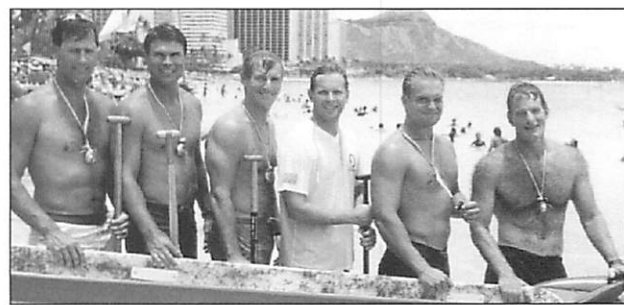
Mary Philpotts-McGrath presents team trophy to son, Head Coach Billy Philpotts. OCC scored 76 points to Lanikai’s 57.
