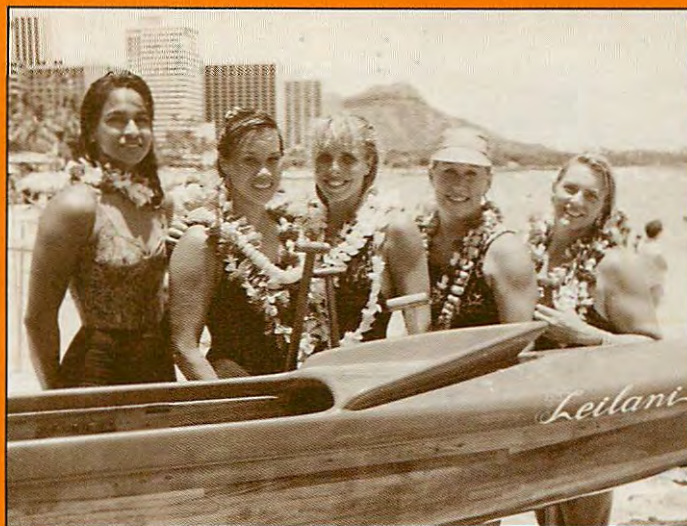
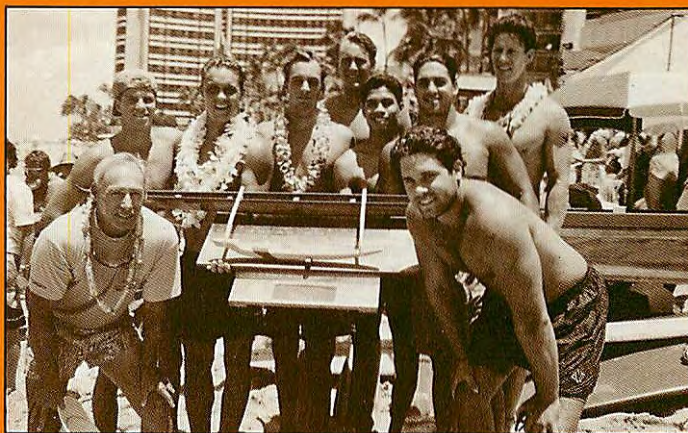

50th Annual 4th of July Macfarlane Regatta A Hit From Dawn to Spectacular Fireworks

The 4th of July was all anyone could have wished for—it was a beautiful sunny day, the surf was running 1-3 feet, Waikiki was packed with paddlers, their families and tourists during the day, and the Club was festive and filled with party-goers during the evening.

The 50th annual Macfarlane Regatta on Waikiki Beach fronting the Moana Hotel was all it was supposed to be. It was a day of camaraderie, upsets, records, swamped canoes, disqualifications, excited winners, disappointed runnersup, and at the end of the day, a tie between the only two clubs in the original Macfarlane Regatta in 1943, Outrigger and Hui Nalu.

Each club won seven events, with assorted seconds, thirds and fourths. OCC was ahead, 61-57 going into the final point-scoring event of the day, the Masters men.

Hui Nalu won the event, with OCC getting one point for fourth, bringing about the tie.

This was the fourth tie in Macfarlane history.

The surf challenged the steersmen. Nearly a dozen canoes swamped or hulled during the regatta, and one club's fiberglass canoe suffered structural damage.

Records were set in seven events—by Outrigger in the Sophomore, Junior and Open 4 Women, by Hui Nalu in the Senior and Masters Men and Girls 16, and by Lanikai in the Girls 18.

But to show just how close the competition really was, in the final event of the regatta, the Makule race for paddlers 50 and older, all seven entrants caught the same wave to the

beach and came across the finish line within 2 1/2 seconds of each other. Hui Nalu edged Outrigger by 1/100th of a second for first place.

In the featured Senior Men's Race for the Matson Trophy, Hui Nalu and Outrigger were on the same wave at the finish line. Hui Nalu finished about a second ahead of OCC, but Outrigger was disqualified on a technicality.

One of the most fun events of the day was the revival of the 1943 Macfarlane Regatta relay race. Wahine paddlers paddled the first half mile. As the women jumped out of the boat, the men jumped in and paddled the final half mile. Hui Lanakila caught a wave to the finish and won the event. Outrigger was second.

Nostalgia was definitely in at the regatta as paddlers from the 1943 Macfarlane Regatta were invited guests in the VIP tent. Among those attending and sharing their reminiscences of the past, was Roselle Robinson Armitage, who came from Maui to celebrate. She was a member of the Senior Girls 6, steered by the late Bob Fischer, who won the first Macfarlane.

Also on hand were John Beaumont, Thad Ekstrand and Tom Arnett, who were all members of the winning Senior Men's 6 in 1943. They were steered by the late Duke Kahanamoku.

Also present were Lorraine Brown Williams, Bill Cook, Ivanelle Mountcastle Choy, Pegg Monahan Melim, Sissy Fuller Fink and Sargent Kahanamoku who paddled on various crews in the early 40s.
