

# OCC Wins Macfarlane Regatta

Making its best showing of the season, Outrigger Canoe Club won the Walter J. Macfarlane Regatta on the 4th of July at Waikiki Beach with 86 points. Hui Nalu was second with 71.

Club teams won 13 events, were second in four races and third in two, climaxing a day full of activities that began with a paddler's breakfast at 6 a.m. and ended with dancing and a party at the Club.

The surf was consistent throughout the day at about 3-feet providing perfect waves for the regatta.

The premiere event of the day, the Senior Men's race, became a threeteam race when a set of large waves

swamped all of the canoes in lanes one to four at the start of the race. Hui Nalu, out of the surf in lane seven, easily won the race. Outrigger's never give up men bailed the Kilakila and finished fourth.

The OCC Boy's 18 crew remained undefeated and set a new record in their event, knocking 11 seconds off the previous record. They finished in 6:41.51, bettering the 1984 record set by OCC of 6:52.9. The time was also the fastest 1-mile time in the history of the race.

The Boy's 18 won the event using their regular steersman, Heath Hemmings, while most crews used open steersmen in the race.

One of the more interesting races of the day was the Masters women's race. The OCC crew caught a wave with several other boats, when they got caught in the trough and couldn't get out. When the wave died, they did a 360-degree turn to get them back to their lane where they finished fourth.

A total of nine canoes were swamped during the regatta.

Muriel Flanders, sister of the late Walter J. Macfarlane after whom the race is named, and her daughter, Alice Guild, were on hand to present trophies and champagne to winning crews.
