The 4th of July dawned with sunny skies and 2-3 foot surf. Outrigger Canoe Club paddlers gathered for a great breakfast buffet on the Hau Terrace, an inspirational talk by Walter Guild, and the annual Outrigger cheer that rattles the glassware in the Bar.

And then it got better. Manu Boyd, Leinaala Heine Kalama, Stephanie Smart and Robert Cazimero welcomed the crowd of more than 3,000 paddlers to Waikiki Beach with their songs and chants while a pod of dolphins frolicked in the surf in lane one of the 62nd Annual Walter J. Macfarlane Regatta race course.

At 8:30 a.m. the first of 37 races ranging from one-quarter to 1-1/2 miles began. With enough surf to make it fun and interesting, open steersmen showed off their skills as they paddled their crews onto waves.

In seven events, the difference between first and third place was hundredths of a second as several boats rode

in on the same wave and only the judges could determine who crossed first.

Outrigger's kid crews scored points in all but one race they entered, putting Outrigger two points behind leader Kailua at the halfway point in the regatta.

Then the OCC's upper division crews launched their assault on the waves, winning the Novice B Mixed, and Novice A, Sophomore, Junior, Senior, 40 and 55 women's races. Outrigger won the Freshmen Women's race by 21 seconds but was DQ'd for bumping a canoe which had encroached in its lane.

The OCC men brought home seconds in the Novice A, Junior, Senior, 40, 50, 55 and Open 4 events to seal the victory for the home team.

The Senior Men's race was too close to call from the beach as Hui Lanakila won the event for the first time, finishing in 10:39.95 to Outrigger's 10:41.33. As a jubilant Hui Lanakila paddler said after the race, "I never thought I'd live and

paddle long enough to beat Outrigger, Lanikai and Hui Nalu in the Senior race." They were grinning from ear to ear as they drank champagne from the Matson trophy and celebrated the victory.

For spectators it was a day of oohs and aahs, as canoes caught and missed waves, went sideways on a wave, paddled across lanes in search of a bump, and then made the fast paddle back to finish in the right lane. There were huli, swamped boats crossing the finish line, sunburns, champagne in the silver perpetual trophies, and all of the fun of the 4th of July Waikiki Beach regatta.

At the end of the day, despite not entering five events, Outrigger outscored second place Hui Lanakila, 87-66. It was the first victory of the Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association for OCC in 2004.

The regatta season ends with the HCRA championships Saturday, August 7 at Keehi Lagoon.
