

Surf Rules at Macfarlane Regatta

The Walter J. Macfarlane Regatta on the 4th of July at Waikiki Beach was an event that will be remembered for a long time. The race is touted as the only surf race on the Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association regatta schedule, and it exceeded all expectations.

A big south swell hit beaches on the 3rd of July, and hung around long enough to provide thrills and spills for the 61st Macfarlane. With surf ranging from flat in some races, to wave faces of up to 6-feet in others, it was a day for the best steersmen the OHCRA clubs could produce. And even with all their expertise, there were huli, swampings and collisions as the surf rolled across the race course.

At the end of the day, Lanikai Canoe Club ruled, gathering 90 points to host Outrigger's 74, to capture the winning trophy. Lanikai also won the prestigious Senior Men's and Women's races and got to drink champagne out of the perpetual trophies.

For the first time, a new perpetual trophy was awarded to the Club that scored the most points in the 18 and under races. Lanikai's youth won this trophy too.

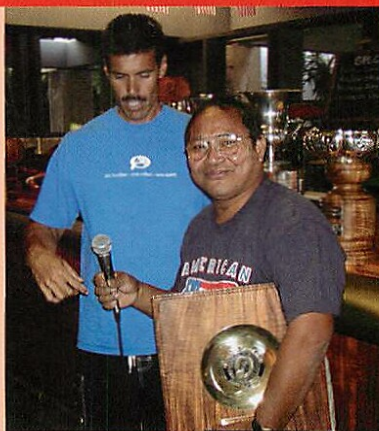
For the record, 13 canoes huli, six finished in the wrong lane, and two were disqualified for interference, two for false starts and one for finishing with only five paddlers.

At times waves broke across all seven lanes, and as many as five canoes were on the same wave as the canoes raced to the finish line. Often, only hundredths of a second separated the photo finishes.

However, the 61st Macfarlane didn't compare to the 1969 race when there were only 13 events and nine clubs competing. That year, the surf ranged up to eight-feet, and 30 canoes swamped during the regatta. The last big surf was in 1980 when waves ranged from four to seven feet.

The Boys 13s were the first OCC crew to win the gold. Others winning crews were the Girls 15, Girls 16, Boys 18, Sophomore Women, Women 55, Women 50 and the Men 40.

The regatta season winds up with the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association Championships on August 2 at Keehi Lagoon.



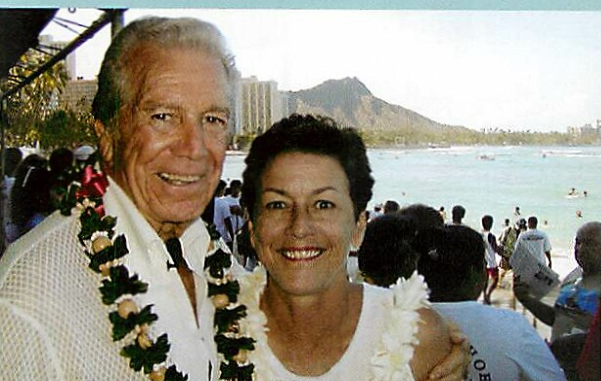
During the Club rally before the race, Canoe Racing Chair Courtney Seto presented Domie Gose with a plaque for his work in restoring the Kakina.

Maile Ostrem won her first regatta race in 26 years (Women's 50). Her sister Maureen Kilcoyne was also a winner (Women's 55).



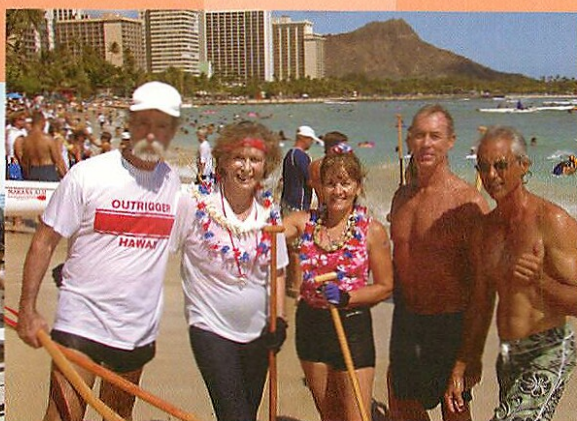

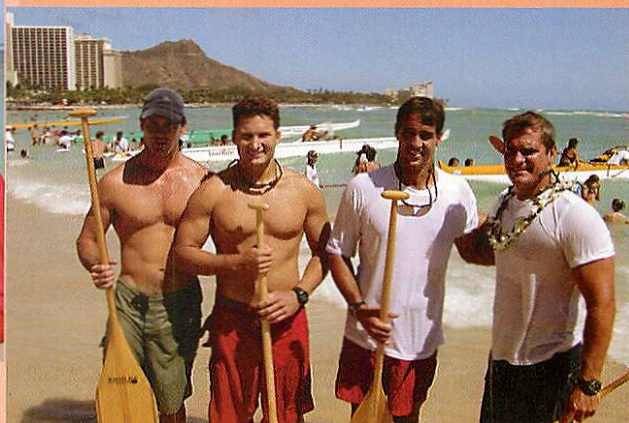
