
Lanikai Wins Thrill-Packed

The 57th annual Walter J.
Macfarlane Regatta got off to
a wild start on July 4 with
four canoes all on the same wave at
the finish flag. With surf ranging
from 1-3 feet most of the day, the
races were close, with hundredths
of a second separating victory from
a third or fourth place finish.

At the end, Outrigger had won eight races, finished second in eight races, and third in six, but it wasn't enough to defeat defending champion Lanikai, which is undefeated this regatta season.

After 30 of the 35 events, Outrigger led Lanikai by 74-67 but Lanikai came back strong, winning four of the last five events scoring 21 points, while OCC didn't have crews in two of the last events and only collected three points.

Lanikai ended the regatta with 88 points to OCC's 77. This year's regatta was dedi-

cated to Walter Flanders, best friend of the late Walter J. Macfarlane, and husband of Macfarlane's sister, Muriel Macfarlane Flanders. Mr. Flanders passed away on July 2, 1999 at the age of 88. Strong supporters of the

events, and the Boys 15 crew was second by less than a second. The women won the Junior and Senior events and were second in the Novice A, Sophomore, Masters 45 and 53 (all by less than a second), and the Sophomore The Masters Men 45 also won their race.

A new perpetual trophy was donated by Muriel Flanders to replace the Senior Women's cup. It will be known as the Muriel Flanders Trophy. The winning senior women's crew will

be invited to drink champagne from the cup as they have in the past.

Sharing the champagne with Outrigger's winning women after the regatta at a ceremony at Duke's Restaurant this year were Muriel's daughters Alice Guild, Mary Philpotts and Judy Flanders. Walter Guild, Muriel's grandson, reported that the new cup had been inaugurated with champagne the previous day by his grandmother and her daughters.

A special thanks to all of our open steersmen for the day Jimmy Austin, Billy Balding, Walter Guild, Marc Haine, Sage Spalding, and Paki Vaughan for their support and encouragement of the crews they steered and for finding the waves or bumps that made the Macfarlane Regatta the highlight of the summer racing season.

Five records were set in the regatta Mixed 12, Boys 15, Novice B Women, Mixed Novice and Sophomore Men.

Special thanks also to the Canoe Racing Committee, chaired by Courtney Seto, and Head Coach David Horner, for their hard work in putting on the Macfarlane Regatta. The event was enjoyed by more than 1,700 participants from 14 OHCRA clubs, as








