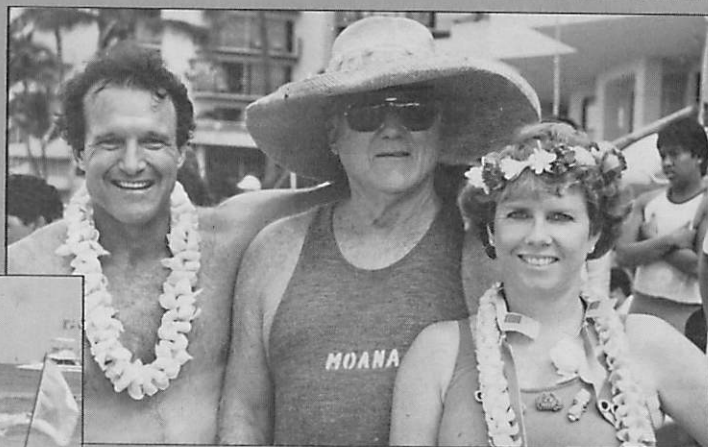
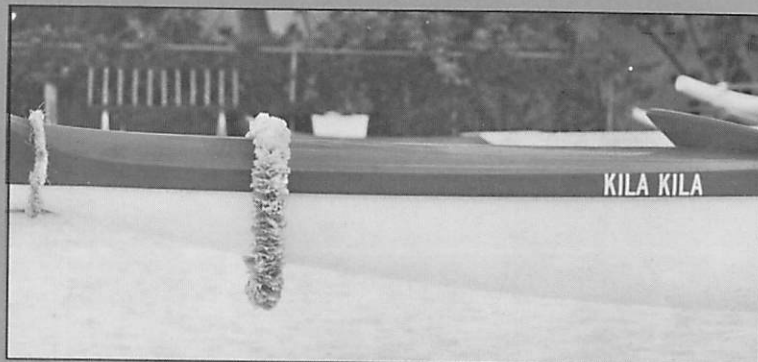
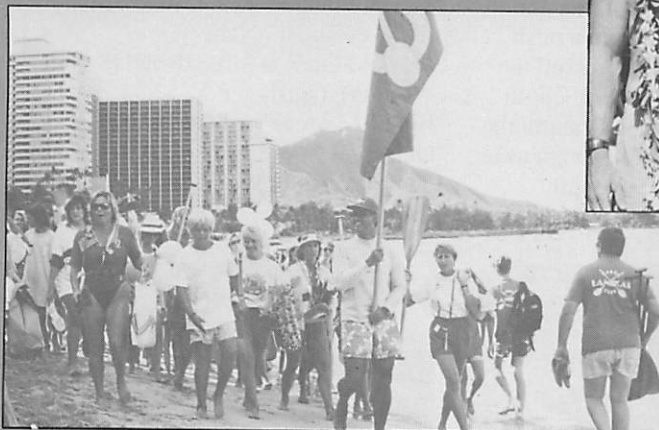

# Outrigger Captures 4th of July Macfarlane Regatta

It was Outrigger Canoe Club's day at Waikiki Beach on the 4th of July as Club paddlers scored points in every event they entered to capture the 45th annual Walter J. Macfarlane Regatta.

Outrigger scored the most points in the history of the race--112--to finish ahead of Hui Nalu, 59 and Kailua, 45.

The kids set the pace for the day as they won the Boy's 12A and 13 and the Girl's 12 and 14 races, and finished second in the Boy's 12B and 14 and Girl's 16 and 18, tallying 37 points before the adults got into the boat. The lead proved insurmountable for the other clubs.

Club paddlers raced in the Club's newest fiberglass canoe, the Kilakila.

The canoe was blessed by Auntie Eva Pomroy in special ceremonies at the paddler's breakfast just before being carried to the water and paddled to Waikiki for the race.

The premiere event of the day, the Senior Men's 2 1/2 mile race, proved to be just that. In a two-boat race, between Outrigger and Kailua, the crews paddled side by side for the first 2 1/4 miles. Then with the last quarter-mile to go, both crews tried to gain a push from a small wave. Kailua missed the wave and fell about half a boat length behind Outrigger. Outrigger caught the next "bump" (it wasn't big enough to be a wave) and won by a boat length.

Five new records were set during the

Regatta, in the men's Senior Masters race and the women's Sophomore, Junior, and Junior and Senior Masters.

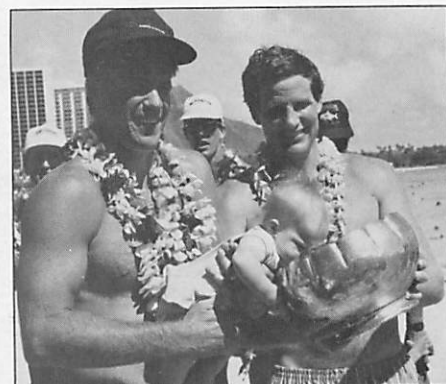

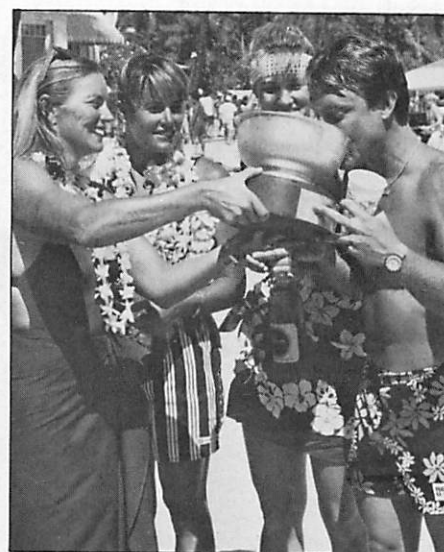
