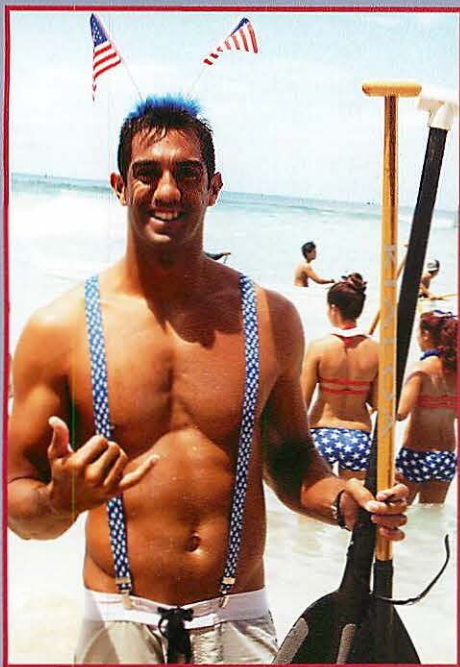
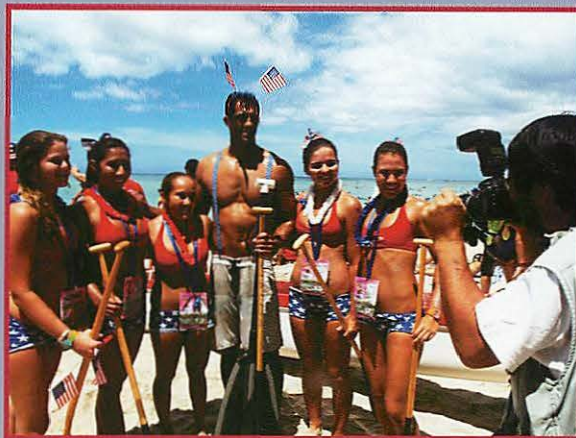


Outrigger Honors the Legacy, Wins 71st Macfarlane Regatta

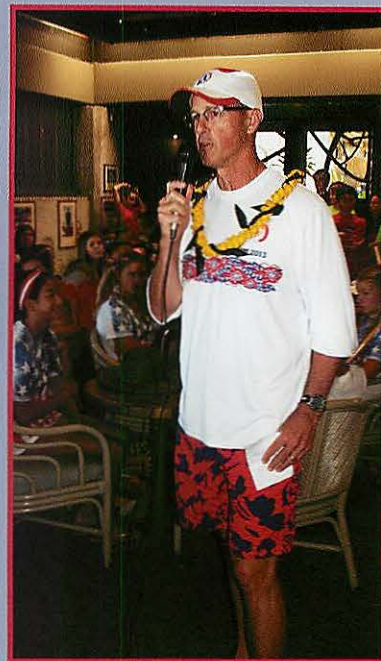

The 2013 OCC Canoe Racing Committee dedicated this season to *Honoring the Legacy*, and they certainly did just that on the 4th of July by winning the 71st Annual Walter J. Macfarlane Memorial Regatta at Waikiki Beach.

In one to three feet of surf, the Club won 12 of 42 events to capture the regatta title with 191 points. Finishing second in the AAA Division was Lanikai with 157 points, Hui Nalu was third with 134 and Kailua fourth with 124. The AA Division was won by Keahiakahoe with 75, and the A Division by Kai Oni with 5 points.

The surf was big enough and waves were frequent enough that most canoes were able to catch a wave during their event making it a really fun day for all. There were a few huli and a broken ama but mostly good fun for crews to enjoy this beautiful, sunny Independence Day.

Outrigger employed the services of 12 different steersmen during the regatta, with Billy Lawson steering nine events, and Jimmy Austin and Al Van Gieson eight each. Others who sat seat six were Billy Balding, Heineri Itchner, Marc Haine, Kisi Haine, Christian Bradley, Jimmy Kincaid, Mike Lum, Ke'ea Lum and Simeon Ke Paloma.

This was a first for Ke'ea who steered his Boys 15 crew to a second place finish, less than half a second behind winner Keahiakahoe.

A special military race at the end of the day saw seven canoe clubs host a different branch of the service. Each canoe was steered by a veteran steersman. OCC hosted a Coast Guard crew. Others competing were the Navy Seals, Army National Guard, Air National Guard, Air Force, Navy Submariners and Marines. The Seals won.

Outrigger, which has been without a women's 65 crew all season, fielded one on the 4th after a full court press by Wendy Wichman to find out who was of that age (and in shape) and could possibly paddle that day.

She finally got six ladies to admit to their age, and they practiced once during the week before the regatta. Since the Club hadn't had a crew in that division all season, it couldn't qualify for a lane, but the race wasn't full so we were able to buy a lane. The ladies drew lane seven, usually considered the least desirable lane.

Once the ladies committed, nothing could hold them back. Not only did they win, but by a full two seconds ahead of Keahiakahoe. Hopefully they'll continue on for the rest of the season. Our thanks to Patty Mowat, Barbara Bryan, Andrea Ray, Barbara Giles, Michele St. John and Penny Bradley for being the competitors that they are.

Due to the recruiting efforts of the Canoe Racing Committee, OCC was able to fill all but one event in the Macfarlane, the first time we've been able to do that in a while.

Congratulations also to the OCC Girls 16 who continued their winning streak which goes back to when they were 14s. The last race they lost was in the 2011 Macfarlane. They have earned state championships as 14s in 2011, and as 15s last year.

The Club competed in the John D. Kaupiko Regatta on July 14 at Kaneohe Bay and the OHCRA Championships on July 21 at Keahi Lagoon. The regatta season winds up with the HCRA Championships August 3 in Hilo. Distance races get underway with the Dad Center Race on August 25.

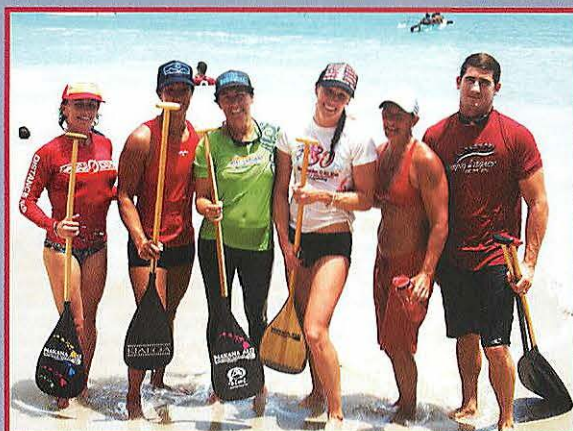


