Report on Memorial Canoe Races July 4, 1950

The Walter James Macfarlane Memorial Canoe Races were held on July 4, 1950, as scheduled with at least two Outrigger Canoes competing in each event. The "Hui Nalu" and Waikiki Surf Club entries were withdrawn at approximately 1045 the day of the races because they objected to the Outrigger entering more than one canoe in each event.

The subject of the number of entries for each race was discussed on Friday, June 30, during the meeting held to draw lanes and the representatives for Hui Nalu and Waikiki Surf Club insisted that only one crew should be entered by each participating organization because they were limited in previous years. The undersigned stated at this meeting that if precedent had definitely established limitations on the number of entries allowed, the Outrigger would only put one canoe in each event.

On the following day it was ascertained that precedent had not been established. It was decided by Messrs. Samuel Fuller, Robert Fischer and the undersigned that the Outrigger would enter one crew in each race for point competition and additional crews would race unattached with no points allowed but they would be entitled to individual awards. Hui Nalu and Waikiki Surf Club were advised of this decision by letter, dated July 1, 1950.

CLUB REPRESENTATIVES MEET

Messrs. William Mullahey, Samuel Fuller and Herbert Taylor met with representatives of Hui Nalu and Waikiki Surf Club at 1030 July 4, 1950 in an effort to resolve the differences but the other organizations refused to enter unless the Outrigger agreed wholly with their requests so the races were held with Outrigger crews competing against each other.

The first race started at 1100 and the last event was completed by 1515. Following are the results of the competition:
