Three in a row for Lanikai

Steersmen key to victory in annual Macfarlane meet

The Lanikai Canoe Club is fast making its own tradition out of the state's most traditional canoepaddling regatta.

Lanikai won its third

consecutive Walter J. Macfarlane Regatta yesterday at Waikīkī Beach. The regatta has been held every year since 1943, and is considered the most prestigious regular-season event in the O'ahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association.

"It's definitely one of our goals every year to try and do well at Macfarlane," said Lanikai head coach Kalani Irvine.

Lanikai won eight of the 35 races vesterday and finished with 71 points. The host club. Outrigger, had its best showing of the season, placing second with 67. Hui Lanakila was third with 57. and Kailua fourth with 44. Healani won the A Division for smaller clubs with 28 points.

In keeping with Macfarlane Regatta tradition, all clubs were allowed-to use "open" steersmen. (Because of the crowds and occasional waves at Waikiki, experienced steersmen help keep the canoes on course).

With its two best steersmen brothers Jim and John Foti away on trips, Lanikai relied on a variety of men to steer.

"Initially, I was (concerned)." said Irvine. "But I think we showed today that we have a bunch of good young steersmen. That was good for us today and good for the future of the club."

Karel Tresnak Jr., 19, was one of those steersmen. He guided three crews to victory.

"Of course, it's a setback not to have Jim and John - they're such amazing paddlers," Tresnak said. "So there was some pressure. I just wanted to go out and not think about that."

Most significant, Tresnak steered Lanikai to a convincing victory in the 2-mile senior men's race. The crew of Mike Pedersen. Mike Judd, Andrew Penny, Mike Beyer and Kai Bartlett paddled to a 47-second win over secondplace Outrigger.

As they have all season, Lanikai again relied on the dominance of its men. After 19 of the 35 races were completed, Lanikai, Hui Lanakila and Outrigger were separated by four points. But Lanikai went on to win the men's freshman, sophomore, junior and senior races to pull ahead for good.

Senior men is considered the top division in regattas, and Lanikai has won it at the Macfarlane Regatta eight consecutive

vears. As a result - in another Macfarlane tradition that is becoming familiar with Lanikai they got to sip champagne out of the Walter Macfarlane Memorial Trophy.

"I just didn't want us to make any mistakes," said Pedersen, who has been on four of the eight victories. "We had some new guys in there, but I knew the crew was good. We train enough together to

Outrigger countered by winning the senior women's race. The crew of Mary Smolenski, Brooke Berrington, Lisa Livingston, Patricia Nagatani and Kisi Haine paddled, while Marc Haine steered. They edged Hui Nalu by four seconds to win the Senior Women's Bowl, which also served as a giant champagne glass after the regatta.

"(Marc) was real motivating." Kisi Haine said of her brother, "I'd rather have him back there steer-

ing than myself."

Hui Nalu's narrow secondplace finish was still significant, considering it did not use an open steersman, instead opting for its regular senior steerswoman, Kaui Pelekane.

Overall. Lanikai and Lanakila tied for the regatta lead with eight race victories each. Hui Lanakila's Kalama Heine was the most successful steersman, guiding five different crews to victories.

Outrigger, a perennial power which had not scored more than 46 points or placed higher than third this season prior to yesterday, won six races yesterday.

"We got off to a late start," said first-year Outrigger head coach Kehau Kali. "But we're very excited with how we did today."

Because waters off Waikīkī Beach were generally calm, except for the occasional 1-foot wave, times were relatively slow.

"It was even all the way across," said Irvine. "No lanes had any kind of advantage as far as catching waves. That made it a fun
