Lanikai is the real thing

Paddlers win at Waikiki for fourth victory

The historic and breakthrough year for the Lanikai Canoe Club continued yesterday.

Lanikai won 13 of 33 races to win the Walter J. Macfarlane Regatta at Waikiki Beach. No one from the club could recall when they last won the prestigious event.

"I asked all my older paddlers," said Lanikai head coach Bob Puakea. "They all said that they had never won it during their time, and

some of them have been here over 30 years."

In any case, Lanikai proved yesterday that it is the team to beat this year. After not winning an Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association regatta in 24 years, Lanikai has won four out of five in the last two months.

"About two weeks ago, I was still unsure," said Puakea. "But now, I think we can do it. I see the way our paddlers are performing and I can see the confidence growing. The papers and the TV and the radio were all saying that Lanikai is on a roll. I would say that right now, we are."

Yesterday, it got rolling early. Lanikai won six of the 11 youth races (for ages 18-under) to jump to an

early lead. By the time Lanikai's 18-year-old boys won their race, the club from Windward Oahu had a 20-point lead over the defending champs, Outrigger.

"The kids start it all," said Puakea. "If they do well, the rest of the day will go well."

And so it went, even though Outrigger head coach Kalani Schrader said he was not ready to concede after the youth rac-

"The men have only four races," said Schrader, "so I thought we still had a chance. But I knew it was going to be

tough."

The lead would prove insurmountable. As usual, the Lanikai men made their contribution, winning the freshman, junior and senior races. That only made the final score lopsided.

In the final tally, Lanikai had 98 points. Outrigger was second with 62 and Kailua third with 61. Hui Lanakila won the A Division (for clubs entering 15 crews or less) with 15 points, edging Anuenue by

three.

Although the ocean off Waikiki was calm yesterday, clubs were allowed to use veteran steersmen for every race for safety reasons. Puakea had lots of praise for two of his primary steersmen - brothers John and Jim Foti.

"I would say they are our best," said Puakea. "The waves were flat, but any little bump can help push you along and our guys can do that with the best of them."

Of Lanikai's 13 victories yesterday, John Foti steered five and Jim Foti guided four.

"There were a few little ripples," said Jim. "You just had

Schrader, whose Outrigger teams have won 11 of the last 12 state championships, said Lanikai is the clear-cut favorite to win it all this year.

"We would have to be at our absolute best to beat them," he said. "They have a lot of momentum. It would take an unbelievable effort to beat them this year.

"I congratulate them wholeheartedly, but I have to be honest - this hurts."
