Host paddlers reclaim title in 52nd Macfarlane regatta

Outrigger Canoe Club re- teams with 15 crews or fewer. claimed its trophy at the 52nd Walter J. Macfarlane Memorial Canoe Regatta yesterday at Waikiki Beach.

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period between races. Outrigger won the race that did not count, finishing ahead of Lanikai. In the rematch, Lanikai triumphed.

Despite the outcome, "I told our women they should feel good about what they did,"

Philpotts said.

Outrigger's winning crews were: girls 12, men's novice b, women's novice a, men's novice a, men's freshmen, women's sophomore, men's junior, women's senior and women's open 4.

The victory came eight days after OCC finished fourth at the Waimanalo Regatta, won by Kailua, which was third

yesterday.

"There was only an 11-point

difference from first to fourth," Philpotts said of the Waimanalo race. "You can't complain about that. Everybody's brought up the level of paddling, so you take what you can get. But it feels good. We got lucky today, we got a lot of good waves so we came out on top."

A recipient of that luck was Outrigger's men's freshmen team of David Potter, Andrew Glatrel, Michael Fine, Hunter Eggers and Paul Friese, with Philpotts as steersman. They won their one-mile race with a time of 6 minutes, 42.92 seconds, some 41 seconds ahead of second-place Lanikai.

"We caught a wave outside the quarter-mile marker," Philpotts said. "We had it kind of free and easy so we ended up having a really, really fast time for a mile race."

Unlike most regattas, which feature lanes that run parallel to the shore, the Macfarlane's lanes head out to sea and back. Crews never know which lane will get the right wave that can carry a crew toward the finish line. Or when.

"Last year, it came down to the final event of the day with Hui Nalu," Philpotts said. "That easily could've happened with Lanikai, Kailua and Hui Nalu this time."

Outrigger also won the makule race for paddlers 50 years and older. The crew of Tay Perry, Kawika Grant, Norm Dunmire, Carol Wilcox, Keanuenue Rocheleau and Marc Haine clocked in at 1:35.42 in the quarter-mile race.
