# Hui Nalu rolls on

### First in Macfarlane by just seconds

Two seconds in the final race of the day provided the difference as Hui Nalu captured the overall title in the 51st Walter J. Macfarlane Memorial Canoe Regatta yesterday at Waikiki

Winning the last two races of the day - the women's and men's masters divisions - Hui Nalu finished with 69 total points. Outrigger Canoe Club, the host club which had won or shared the overall title the past nine years, finished second with 66.

Last year, the same two clubs tied for the overall title.

"The competition was tight the whole day," said Pinky Thompson, president of Hui Nalu. "It felt good last year when we tied, but this feels even better because it's ours."

The final result, however, did not

come easy or without drama.

After 27 of the 30 races had been completed, Hui Nalu, Outrigger and the Lanikai Canoe Club were all deadlocked at the top with 57 points.

Outrigger won the men/women mixed race to move temporarily ahead, but the two masters division races loomed.

"A lot of the paddlers in our masters crews have been with us since we last won this regatta (in 1983),"

Thompson said. "They know how to work together."

The Hui Nalu women masters did their share, winning the over-35, 1mile race with a time of eight minutes, 16.19 seconds. Kailua finished second less than two seconds later. and Outrigger finished a distant third.

We didn't even know what the situation was," said Becky Hara, a member of the winning crew. "To be honest, I wasn't really thinking about it until after we came in.'

The result left Hui Nalu and Outrigger knotted at 64 entering the men's masters race.
