Qahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association competition moves to Waikiki Beach on the 4th of July for the 48th annual Walter J. Macfarlane Regatta.

More than 1,200 paddlers from 16 OHCRA clubs are expected to compete in the 31 events which get underway at 8:30 a.m. on the beach in front of the Moana/Surfrider Hotels.

The event, sponsored by the Outrigger Canoe Club annually since 1943 is the oldest on-going canoe race in Hawaii. The Macfarlane Regatta is the only surf race on the OHCRA schedule and one of the most popular.

Competing clubs will have their choice of fiberglass or koa canoes. Although OHCRA requires koa canoes in all of its other races, fiberglass canoes may be used in the Macfarlane because of possible damage to the priceless koa because of the waves.

Clubs are also allowed open steersmen. The surf and the ability of the steersman to catch a wave is the great equalizer in the race, giving any crew a chance to bring home the gold medal.

Host Outrigger, paddling in its own waters, has dominated the Regatta, including five straight wins in the past five years and 12 victories in the past 15 years. The only team to beat them during this period is Hui Nalu.

The premiere race of the day is the Senior Men's 2 1/2 mile event. Hui Nalu is the defending champion and has won the event the last two weeks in OHCRA races. However, both Kailua, which won the first two senior men's races of the season, and Outrigger, which just returned from Australia and a victory in the Hamilton Cup, are expected to be tough competition for the Walter Macfarlane Memorial Trophy and the bowl of champagne that go with it.

Races will also be held for both men and women in age groups from 12-year-olds to senior masters (45 and older) and will even include a special makule event (50 years and older).

Paddlers in the 1/4-mile races will start at flags one-quarter mile from the beach, paddle through the surf and finish near the beach. Paddlers in longer races will begin their races at the beach, paddle into the surf, turn at either the quarter-mile or half-mile flags and return to the beach.

Ten OHCRA crews remain undefeated after the first four regattas of the season. These include Outrigger's Girl's 18s, Junior Men and Senior Masters Women; Nui Nalu's Girl's 12s, Boy's 18s and Masters Women; Kailua's Novice B Women and Senior Masters Men; Leeward Kai's Boy's 13s and Healani's Boys 14s.
