WSC in slim

a disallowed protest made all the difference in the Walter J. MacFarlane canoe regatta yesterday.

Waikiki Surf Club edged Outrigger Canoe by fourtenths of a second in the final event, and thus captured the team championship in the 12-race competition off Waikiki Beach.

Earlier, Outrigger won the day's premier event-the senior men's two-mile-then protested the second-place finish of WSC, claiming the Waikiki Surf boat hit a flag But officials turning. on ruled otherwise and the protest was denied.

In winning the windup freshmen men's race, WSC gained five points for a total of 44. OCC received three points for second, ending up with 41. Had Waikiki Surf

Four ticks of the stopwatch been disqualified in the senthree points and a first-place tie would have resulted in the team standings. Approximately 10,000 spec-

tators watched the regatta as it literally went down to the wire before the over-all title

was decided. Going into that last race, Walkiki Surf led DCC in points, 39-38. WSC won the one-miler, in the record time of 8 minutes, 4.6 seconds and OCC was clocked in 8:05.0, also bettering the meet mark of 8:07.7 |set by Outrigger last year.

In the featured senior men's race. Outrigger took first with a time of 16:45.6, 1.8 seconds ahead of runnerup WSC

Two other records were set in addition to WSC's in the finale. Walkiki Surf accounted for one in the senior worden's one-mile (9:14.1) and Outrigger made the other in the women's halfanile junior (4:40.4).

WSC's victories were in the boys-13-and-under, novace women, novice men, senior women and freshmen men races. Outrigger won the boys-14-and-under, b o ys-16and-under, freshmen women, junior women and senior women along with the senior 'men's main event.

Following WSC OCC in the team standings were Healani (16 points), Lanikai (10), Leeward Kai (9), Hui Walu (8r, Maile (3) and Order of Kamehameha (1).
