## OCC Men Win Koa and Masters 35 in Molokai Hoe

Outrigger's men made a terrific showing in the 51st annual 2002 Hinano Molokai Hoe on October 11, winning the Koa and Masters 35 Divisions, placing fifth overall, and fifth in the Masters 45 Division.

The 41-mile race from Hale O Lono Harbor on Molokai to Waikiki Beach was won by Rai of Tahiti in 5:11:35. Team New Zealand/Hawaii was close behind in 5:11:55 for second place.

Outrigger's fiberglass crew finished 10 minutes later in 5:21:44 in the Club's new Henry Keawe Ayau canoe.

The Masters 35 finished 10th overall, and first in the Masters 35 in 5:34:50. They paddled in the *Helumoa*.

The koa crew finished 21st overall and first in koa in 5:51:29. They raced in the newly refurbished canoe, *Kakina*.

The Masters 45 completed the course in 7:01:49, finishing 5th in the masters 45 division, and 87th overall. They raced in the fiberglass canoe, *Eleu*.

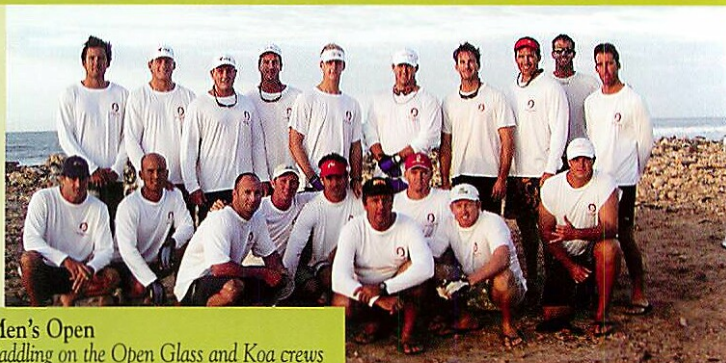

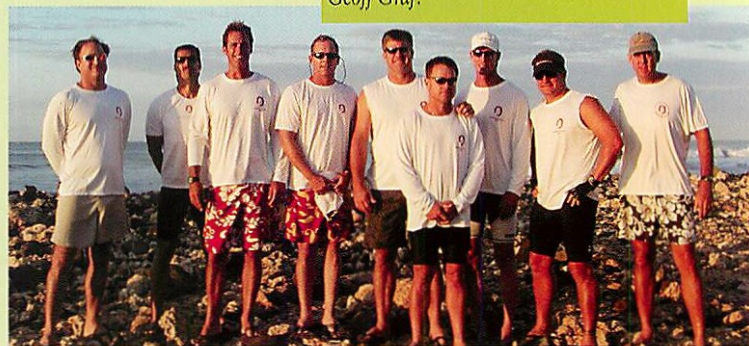
