Hawaiian Canoe Club Wins Dad Center Race

On the calm, still morning of August 28th, 47 canoes were at the starting line of the Dad Center long distance race. The race course starts at Kailua Beach, runs around Makapu'u, past Hanauma Bay, Hawaii Kai and Black Point, around the Diamond Head buoy and finishes at the Outrigger Canoe Club.

This year's race was won by an all-star crew from Hawaiian Canoe Club on the Big Island. Their winning time was 3:13:28.7.

The first OCC canoe crossed the finish line in third place in a time of 3:18.50. According to OCC coach, lan Forester, it was a hard fought battle for third place. The second OCC crew placed tenth overall in a time of 3:34.38. OCC's third crew finished in 3:49:33.3, and the fourth OCC crew finished in 3:59:37.6.

Although the women look forward to the Dad Center race each year, this year's race was run in hot, humid conditions. The ocean was flat and glassy, perfect conditions for watersking. There were some waves coming in the channel at Outrigger, but other than that, it was pretty much a bump free race.

This race gave coaches the opportunity to figure out combos and gave paddlers the opportunity to practice open ocean changes during a race. Based on the strong showing of OCC crews, paddlers are looking forward to the rest of distance season which concluded with the Na Wahine O Ke Kai race on September 24.

The Dad Center race is especially fun for OCC paddlers since it is organized and sponsored by the Outrigger. As the canoes rounded the yellow buoy and passed the wind sock in the channel leading to the Club, paddlers were cheered on by Outrigger members. There's nothing like finishing a paddling race at your Club, greeted by friends and family, a warm shower and a delicious lunch prepared by the Outrigger chefs.
