In the end though, 20 women raced for the Club, but it was always understood that it took other paddlers who participated throughout the season, but did not make crew, to help push these two crews to be the best they could be.

The first crew included Mary Smolenski, Nicole Pederson, Malia Kamisugi, Lisa Livingston, Tricia Nagatani, Katy Bourne, Paula Crabb, Sara Ackerman, Sasha MacNaughton, and steered by Kisi Haine.

They were in a tight race with Wailua Kayak & Canoe for 3rd place, but the 1999 defending champions edged them out. They finished a respectable 4th with a time of 6:06:10.
