## Healani paddles off with State canoe title

Canoe Club turned back two other Oahu entries to capture the team championship here yesterday in the first statewide Hawaiian Canoe Racing Championships conducted in a decade.

The strong Healani team tallied 46 points to 38 for runner-up Kailua Canoe Club and 34 for third-place Lanikai.

Two Neighbor Island teams cut into the all-Oahu victory parade.

The Kauai Canoe Club's women scored a pair of upsets, including a triumph over the previously undefeated Healani women's nowice team in the quarter-mile fifth race.

The Healani entry had entered the event as the State's only undefeated

HILO'S PRINCE David Kawananakoa Civic Club scored a major upset by defeating favored Healani in the junior men's twomile test, overcoming a sudden surge neaf the finish by the Oahuans.

But Healani, Hawaii's oldest active canoe club. had superior depth and scored either first or second nine times in the first 15 events.

The Ala Wai canal team finished with three victories in men's and boy's events, added a women's triumph and took a total of six second places.

The triumph was a re-

peat since Healani captured the last statewide event which also was staged in Hilo Bay in 1964.

More than 1,200 paddlers raced before a crowd estimated at more than 4,500 persons which ringed Hilo Bay for more than a mile an a half.
