

# Healani Wins Canoe Regatta

Healani won both the feature men's two-mile race and the State Outrigger Canoe Regatta team championship with 38 points yesterday at Kaneohe Marine Air Station beach.

The Healani paddlers covered the two-mile distance in 16:46.5, to easily outdistance Outrigger Canoe Club, timed in 17:04.5 and Kauai, 17:58.0. Waikiki Surf was fourth in 17:58.4.

Outrigger was the defending champion in the race.

Outrigger was also second in team standings with 30, followed by Hui Nalu with 17

and Kailua 12, Waikiki Surf 9, Kauai 8, Leeward Kai 8, Lanikai 7 and Kai Oni 3.

A crowd of approximately 3,000 watched the race from fine vantage points, while the races progressed under

ideal conditions.
