

Outrigger Captures Canoe Racing Title

KAHULUI, Maui—Outrigger Canoe Club, entering crews in all 11 events, yesterday edged rival Waikiki Surf Club, 35-31, in capturing the 1960 State championship canoe regatta for the first time in Kahului Harbor.

Several thousand persons lined the harbor area to take in the first state championship race ever to be held on Maui.

YESTERDAY'S regatta, sponsored by the Hawaii Ca-

noe Racing Association, honored the late Frank Fowler Baldwin "because of the great love he had for sports and for Hawaii and its people."

Kai Oni followed Waikiki Surf in third place with 11 points followed by Lanikai 10, Healan and Kauai nine apiece, Hui Nalu six, Kai Opua five, Kahului three and Hawaiian Canoe Club (Maui) two.

Outrigger won the men senior two-mile blue ribbon

event of the day over WSC with a time of 17:04.5. The winning crew was made up of Nick Beck, Bob Moncrief, Henry Hollinger, Douglas Carr, Timmy Guard and coach George Downing.

Outrigger clinched victory by winning four races, finishing second three times and third and fourth twice each.

Waikiki Surf also won four races and three second places but entered crews in only nine of the 11 events. Dutchy Kino's Surfers had no third place finishers but bagged fourth place in two races.

An awards luau at the Kahului Fairgrounds and a dance at the Kahului Shopping Center climaxed the regatta.
