

Waikiki Surf Club Victorious

Six Records Shattered In Yates Canoe Regatta

KAILUA, Kona, Hawaii, Aug.

6—Three Territorial canoe racing records and as many course records were broken here today as the Waikiki Surf Club of Honolulu won the Julian Yates Territorial championship regatta with 34 points.

Hui Nalu and Outrigger Canoe Club, both of Honolulu, were tied for second place with 15 points. Kai Oni of Oahu tallied 14, Honaunau of Kona seven,

Lanikai five, Waiakea of Hilo four, Hui Kalia four, and Kai Opua of Kona one.

It was the third time that the Waikiki Surf Club had won the regatta title. As a result the club retired the Julian Yates trophy.

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The club's victory in the senior six also marked its third win in the race and enabled it to retire the Kona Inn trophy.

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Before several thousand spec-

tators and under ideal racing conditions, Waikiki Surf Club won the men's senior six and four, women's senior six, and the boys 17 and under events.

Hui Nalu won the men's junior six and four races, while Kai Oni took top honors in the freshmen six and boys 15 and under events. Outrigger Canoe Club annexed the men's junior six honors.

The excellent weather conditions and smooth sea were conducive to the breaking of six records.

The men's junior six of Hui Nalu set a Territorial mark of 16 minutes 48 seconds.

The Outrigger Canoe Club's women's junior six paddlers emerged with a Territorial record when it negotiated the one-mile course in 9 minutes 43.5 seconds.

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Hui Nalu set another Ter-

ritorial record later in the regatta when its men's junior four crew registered 8:48.8 in beating Waikiki Surf Club which was also under the former record of 9:35 with an effort of 8:52.5.

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The freshmen six of Kai Oni (Oahu) set a course record as it triumphed in 8 minutes 14 seconds. The men's senior four crew of Waikiki Surf Club also set a course record in being timed at 8:29.8.

The third course record was set by Waikiki Surf Club's senior paddlers who beat Hui Nalu in 24 minutes 14.4 seconds. Waikiki led all the way. Hui Nalu was second in 25:15.4.

The closest race of the day saw the Waikiki Surf Club crew edge out Outrigger by four-tenths of a second in the women's senior six event. It was neck-and-neck all the way. Waikiki
