Outrigger Second In Hilo Races

HILO, Aug. 4 (Via Radiophone)—Waikiki Surf Club triumphed in the blue ribbon men's senior six three-mile event to win the fourth annual Territorial canoe paddling champions today by three points over the Outrigger Canoe Club.

The races, sponsored by the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association and held in honor of Duke P. Kahanamoku, were held in a virtual downpour. Despite the wind and rain, several hundred spectators watched the races in Hilo harbor.

Choppy waters and backwash hampered the paddlers but one new record was established.

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A crew of Dutchy Kino, Moses Perkins, Sam Steamboat, Jema Kekai, Blackie Makaena and Wally Froiseth paddled the WSC to victory in the gruelling three-mile senior six event. The winning time was 25 min. 23.01 sec.

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Outrigger was second and Healani third.

By winning this event, the finale of the program, Waikiki Surf won the championship with 37 points to 34 for OCC. Louis Kahanamoku, president of the association, presented the Duke Kahanamoku perpetual trophy, a replica of an outrigger canoe, to Waikiki Surf.

Ten clubs participated in the program. Kai Oni was third with 14 points, followed by Hui Nalu with 11, Hilo with eight, Kauai with seven, Healani with five, Holomua with two and Kamehameha with one. Kai Opua failed to score a single point.

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Kai Oni set the only new record of the day in winning the junior men's four over one mile in 8 min. 44.04 sec. The old record of 8 min. 48.08 was held by Hui Nalu.

Before the program county Chairman James Kealoha presented a koa key to Duke Kahanamoku.
