Hui Nalu's Sandy Combis, Jenny Scafe, Lorey Bode, Ann Malama, Diane Almadova, Kate Jonnson, Lindsey Styan, Becky Hara and Denice Darval finished in 3 hours, 3 minutes, 53 seconds. The previous record was 3:18:58, set by Outrigger in 1985.
