

Outrigger CC gets ready for states

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John Finney, the president of Burger King, spent \$10,000 of his company's funds in sponsoring yesterday's Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Championship at Keehi Lagoon. And despite the considerable outlay, Finney left the regatta beaming.

"Worth every penny for several reasons," he said. "But what really made our day," Finney added, "my wife Tiare and I both paddled on winning crews, and Outrigger Canoe Club, our team, won the regatta."

And, Finney said, participants yesterday consumed more than 2,000 of his burgers.

"John and Tiare were among our outstanding adult paddlers who really came through for us," Outrigger coach Mike Fox said after his club's late surge in topping second place Kailua Canoe Club, 82-74.

"No question. It was our adult crews that pulled it off," Fox said. Defending Oahu champ Outrigger, trailing by eight points after 20 of 30 events, proceed to win eight of the remaining 10 heats, including six races in a row.

"Our goal coming into this championship was to qualify as many crews for the State Championship (Aug. 6) as possible," Fox said. Outrigger's unflappable coach had hoped that by qualifying a lot of crews, winning the state regatta will take its course.

Outrigger's game-plan went picture perfect. The defending Oahu and State champ won 12 heats yesterday to Kailua's five, plus it qualified crews in 24 of 30 state events.

Kailua, the club that has the best chance of defeating Outrigger, did one
