

# OHCRA Title to Healani

Youth served well in yesterday's Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association Championship Regatta at Keehi Lagoon as Healani, relying on its young paddlers to build up a big lead, captured its first title of the year.

Healani edged three time defending champion Hui Nalu by a scant three points, 59-56, after finishing second five points to Outrigger in last week's regatta.

Healani's young crews did their best to avert another second place finish yesterday. They amassed 36 points, winning the Boys' 13, Girls' 13, Boys' 14, Boys' 16 and Girls' Novice B.

Still, the regatta came down to the

final race of the day, the prestigious Senior Men's event. A Hui Nalu victory would give them their fourth-straight title. But the defending champs could manage on a third-place finish, behind Kailua and Outrigger, to give Healani its title.

Meanwhile, in the Hui Wa'a and Surfing Association, the Waikiki Beach Boys won their own regatta thanks to an impressive performance from their women's crews.

While the Beach Boys' men's crews were shut out, their women won the Novice B, Girls' 15, Girls' 17, Freshmen, Sophomore and Junior races to help the club to a 52-39 victory over runner-up Ka Mo'i.
