Long Distance Racing Season Underway

Outrigger's ho'e wa'a members rolled out of the State Championships into distance racing with the 43rd Annual Duke Kahanamoku Race from Lanikai to Waikiki on August 15. Team Primo, representing Wailea Canoe Club of Maui, topped the 49 crews entered in the 26-mile race with a time of 2:54. Team Primo was last year's runner-up to the Tahitians who dominate the Molokai Hoe.

The runners-up followed about a half minute later: Hui Lanakila (2:58.24), Lanikai (3:00.08), Team Livestrong (3:00.44) and in fifth, Outrigger Canoe Club (3:04.15). "We got spanked," Jimmy Austin conceded. Outrigger Masters men took the Masters Division in 3:13:30, while another OCC men's crew won the Koa Division in 3:26:01.

There are just a handful of distance races – two men's and two women's events – culminating in the Na Wahine O Ke Kai and Molokai Hoe, the women's and men's versions of the 41-mile Molokai-to-Oahu race.

On August 22, the wahine raced the same course in Outrigger's Dad Center Race. Hawaiian Kanaktion, a nucleus of former Hui Lanakila paddlers, finished first in a time of 3:11.35, edging Waikiki Beach Boys (3:12.25) and five-time defending Na Wahine O Ke Kai champion, Team Bradley of Hawaiian Canoe Club (3:14.04).

Fifty-seven crews, including a junior crew and a lone koa crew, struggled through windy and choppy conditions off Kailua and Waimanalo, then rode the trade winds and rolling surf after turning around Makapu'u Point.

Outrigger's women entered four crews. Team Red was fourth overall in 3:21.59, Team White finished in 3:42.29, and Team Blue, a crew of undaunted novices, finished in 4:01.24. OCC 40's were the first masters crew to finish, racing the Club's koa canoe, *Kakina*, to finish in a time of 3:30.37.

Both the men and women were in Kona over the Labor Day weekend for the Queen Lili'uokalani Races. Then the wahine raced the E Lau Hoe on September 12, and the kane raced the Henry Ayau Memorial Race on September 19.


