The Kamehamcha Day Canoe Races sponsored by the Hawaiian Canoe Racing and Surfing Association were held on June 12 at Pokai Bay, Waianae. The races were marred by a heavy surf resulting in several swampings and fouls. The OCC Oahu Champs of 1953 made a poor showing and it is hoped that they will improve by July 4th.

The races themselves were a clean sweep for the Waikiki Surf Club. It took first place in nine of the 12 events, with Hui Nalu, the Surf Club's most serious challengers, taking the firsts in the balance of the races.

Team points put the Surf Club at 39, Hui Nalu at 26, Hui Kalia at 12. Outrigger Canoe Club at
