

OAHU CHAMPIONSHIPS OUTRIGGER CANOEING

On Sunday, July 25, under the sponsorship of Lanikai Association, the Oahu Championships were held at Kailua Bay, Oahu. John D. Kaupiko's Hui Nalu Senior Men's 6 Crew won the much coveted

blue ribbon event for the Senior 6 Race. The same crew won the race on July 4 but as the day was marred by heavy waves many believed that the Hui Nalu was lucky. Men Novice (half-mile)—Won by Waikiki Surf Club; second, Healani; third, Lanikai. Time, 4 minutes 10 seconds.

Junior Women Six (one mile)—Won by Outrigger Canoe Club; second, Hui Nalu; third, Waikiki. Time 11:36.6.

Girls Novice Six (half-mile)—Won by Lanikai; second, Waikiki; third, Hui Nalu. Time, 5:25.

Senior Men Four (one mile)—Won by Waikiki; second, Hui Nalu; third, Hui Kalia. Time, 9:20.9.

Men Freshmen Six (one mile)—Won by Waikiki; second, Kai Oni; third, Hui Nalu. Time, 9:30.4.

Senior Six Men (three miles)—Won by Hui Nalu; second, Waikiki; third, Healani. Time 28:10.
