Aaron Napoleon has truly solidified his supremacy as Hawaii's (and maybe the world's) paddleboard "king" with his record-smashing performance of 1:09:55 in the Outrigger Canoe Club's 7th Winter Race. Kisi Haine regained her crown as the paddleboard "queen" in the record-setting time of 1:30:27.

Napoleon, a very successful amateur surfer, bested the previous record time in this annual paddleboard marathon set in December of 1982 by ironman Bret Goodfriend who dominated this elite sport until the arrival of the Napoleons. Aaron was joined in his triumph of December 29, 1984 by his brothers Joey, Darryn and David. Their happy parents both attended and, in fact,


delivered them and their special competition boards via their powerboat.

She was the reigning paddleboard queen until Wailana Kaipaka broke Kisi's record in August of '84 with a time of 1:45:34. December 29, 1984, was the day for the return of the crown. Twenty-five sea stalwarts churned the waters offshore of host OCC at the start but one dropped out due to fatigue. Two competitors, the 2nd & 3rd places overall, hailed from California.

Race Director Cline Mann remarked

that this race drew "not the largest but the classiest-caliber field ever and the sea conditions were ideal-flat, glassy and with an unusual current favoring the first leg out to the Diamond Head Wreckbuoy." Mahalo to the faithful cast and crew of putting on the race -Cline Mann (delighted to use the Club's new "Bose" PA system, retiring the megaphone), Dale Hope, Aggie Quigg, Baby Cross, Wayne Faulkner, and, of course, our Club, which has made this race open to the public twice a year since 1978. Prizes were generous this time with gifts from Downing Hawaii, Scott Hawaii, Hawaiian Style and Joey Cabell's Chart House Restaurant.
