BUDGETS: Mr. Thomas announced that today's meeting would concern itself

primarily with 1970 committee budgets and that the December 11th meeting would pursue operating budgets and a combined general

budget for 1970.

ATHLETIC Mr. Balding outlined a tentative Athletic Committee budget of

PADDLE TENNIS: Mr. Balding reported, the Athletic Committee concurred with the

Buildings and Grounds Committee, i.e., the club's design does not lend itself to the addition of a paddle tennis court, although the interest in this sport is appreciated, therefore, for aesthetic reasons a temporary wood and steel structure

could not be recommended.

Mr. Thomas stated he would convey the committee's decision to

Mr. Alan Kruse who suggested the court.

JASP : In a review of the Junior Athletic Summer Program, Mr. Balding reported that the committee felt too much emphasis was directed

to professional staffing, and that next year's program would gear down this aspect; also, transportation was considered too expensive - that more activities would be conducted on club premises or immediate areas to the club. Mr. Balding stated further that the program should be self-sustaining and that next

year's figures would be adjusted to this end wherever necessary.

GEORGE Mr. Balding related background of his request to reimburse
