John Parks, son of Attorney John E. Parks, became the second isle swimmer to crack the 50 second mark for the 100-yard freestyle.

The 6'7" sprinter, who graduates from Indiana University this June, was clocked at 49.9 for a new Indiana pool record. In the same meet Parks churned the 50-yard free event in 22.6 sec. Last year he was named to the All American team.

John returned to the island last summer as a newlywed and performed brilliantly in the annual Keo Nakama meet.

In cracking the 50 second barrier, Parks became the second islander to perform the feat. Dick Cleveland, Outrigger board member, set the world record for the 100-yard event with a 49.2 while at Ohio State.
