Aileen Riggin Soule has been named a Grand Dame of the International Swimming Hall of Fame in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Soule is the

oldest living Olympic gold medal win-

ner. At the 1920 Olympics in Antwerp, Belgium, as a 14-year-old, she won the springboard diving. In the 1924 Olympics in Paris, she won a silver in the springboard diving and a bronze in the 100-meter backstroke. . .
