The surf, combined with a rapidly falling tide that morning, made for a fast down-current swim from Waikiki Beach at the location of the old Outrigger Canoe Club.

However, the 34 swimmers were then faced with a struggle against the current that was flowing out of the Kapua Channel, all the way to the Club steps.

Chris Moore, who covered the approximately 1 1/2 mile course in a time of 29 minutes, 50 seconds, was first out of the water, followed closely by age group winners Mike Miller and Ian Emberson.

The first woman to cross the finish line was Hilary Lambert, with a time of :36:30.

Congratulations to all of our swimmers, including our other first-place age group winners.


