OCC OPEN WATER SWIM

OCC Boys' 600 Yard, 16 and Under—Won by Bill Danford, time 13:31.7, followed by Robert Guard and Gilly Halpern.

Boys', 16 and Under, Open—Won by Donald Miles, time 13.34, followed by Norman Leong, Walter Miyashiro, Dave Gortner, John Layton.

Boys' and Girls', 12 Years and Under, 200 Yard—First, Nancy O'Connor, followed by Bunchie Reeves, and Leslie Baker.

In the girls' and boys' 200 yard, 12 and under swim, Nancy O'Connor finished first, with Bunchie Reeves and Leslie Baker following in close order.

First place winners in all the events, except the 200 yard swim, received gold medals. Silver and bronze medals were awarded to second and third place winners.
