At a recent Board meeting, the ODKF named their newest athletic grantees for 1992-93.

Community and OCC donors have enabled the Foundation to give a total of \$12,000 in scholarships and \$15,550 in athletic grants for the 1992-93 fiscal year which ended September 30, 1993.

\$300 to Summer Craig, Waikiki Yacht Club sailor, to participate in the Leiter Cup at the Houston Yacht Club in Texas in August, 1993. Summer is also a scholarship grantee. The athletic award sends her to compete in the 1993 US Sailing/Rolex Junior Women's Championship for the Nancy Leiter Trophy. This is the first time Hawaii has sent a female junior sailor to compete on a national level.

\$500 to Kathy Colin for kayaking. Kathy used her funds to attend the U.S. Canoe and Kayak Sprints in Indianapolis, Indiana in August 1993. She is a Hui Nalu paddler, and kayaks with the Hawaii Canoe and Kayak Team. She has also kayaked and paddled for Punahou School. She attends the University of Washington and is a member of the women's crew.

\$500 to Kathy-Lyn Allen for swimming. A previous scholarship and athletic grantee, Kathy-Lyn is a student at Auburn University and applied for her grant to compete in the Summer Senior Nationals at the University of Texas in Austin.

\$500 to Jon Allen for swimming. Jon swims for Punahou Aquatics. His grant will send him to the Junior Nationals in Minneapolis and the Senior Nationals in Texas. He will be a sophomore at UH-Manoa this fall, and holds records in 100 and 200 yard backstroke events.
