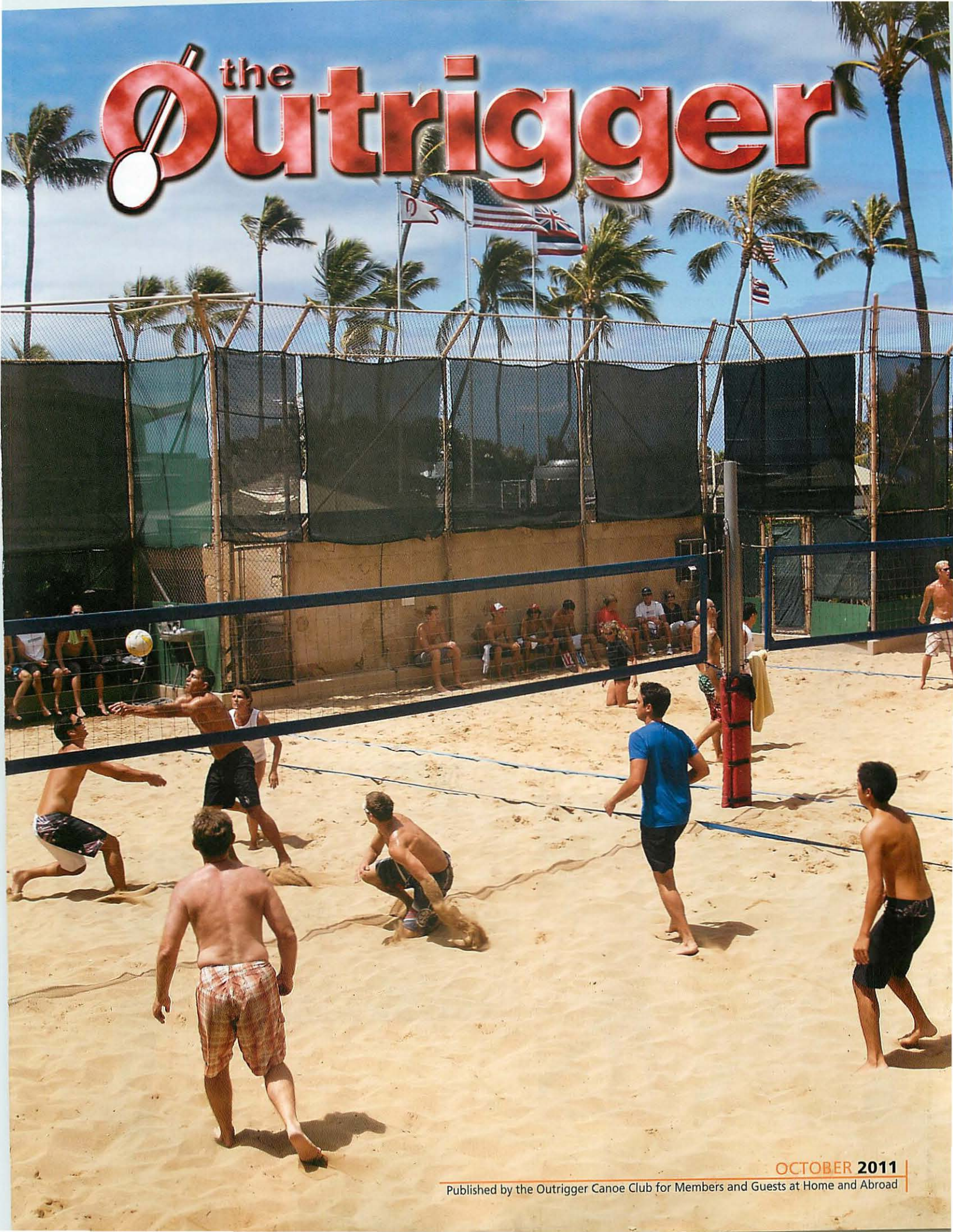

The winners were the team of Stein Metzger, Stan Brown, Rick Humphreys and Jaylen Reyes.

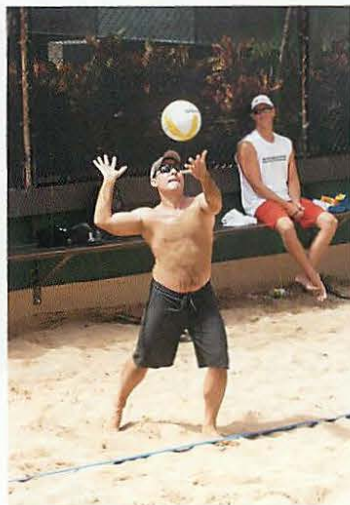

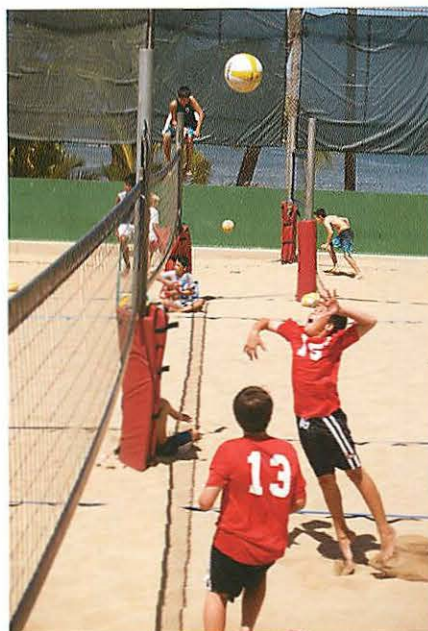

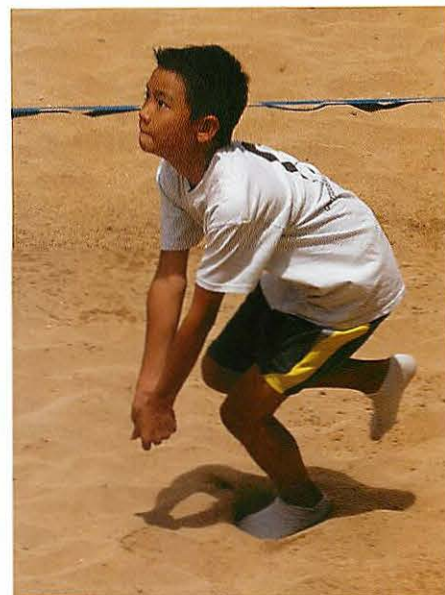
