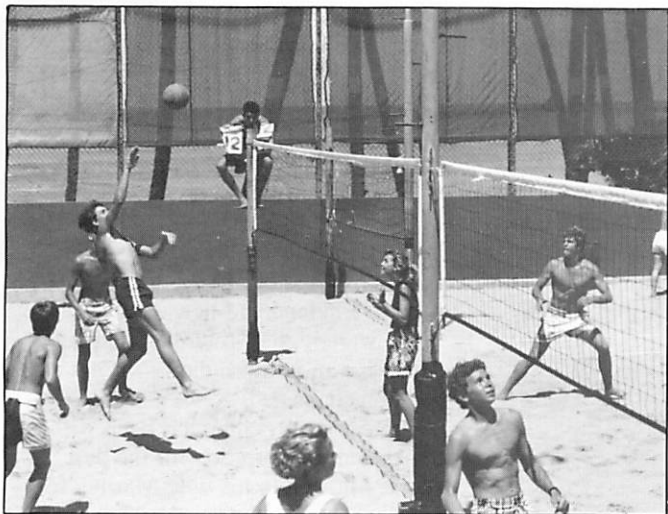


Junior Volleyball Clinic

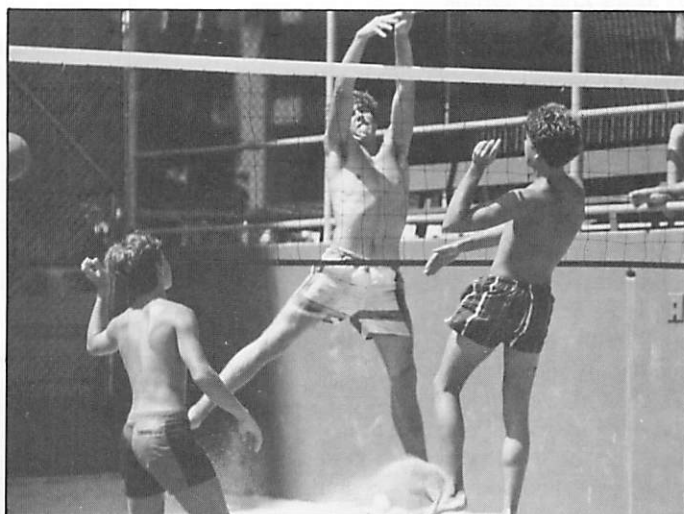


The Volleyball Committee sponsored the event with the purpose of generating enthusiasm among our junior members in the sport.
