This year OCC had five men invited to try out. They were Tom Haine, Peter Velasco, Bob Hogan, Bob Jones and Paul MacLaughlin. Haine, Velasco and Jones had to decline due to prior commitments. MacLaughlin attempted to represent OCC in the tryouts for the championships in Czechoslovakia this year but, after one week of working out in Los Angeles, re-injured the knee he hurt in the Olympic tryouts in New York in 1964. Bob Hogan as a member of the Sand and Sea "Green" team was named the Outstanding Player in the recent Nationals in Grand Rapids and is a sure bet to make the team. Ten men will be picked to play for the U. S. and they will be trying to dethrone Russia, the defending champions. Other teams participating will be Japan, Brazil, Hungary, Czechoslovakia and Russia.

On June 30 the Hawaii Region of the United States Volleyball Association had its awards dinner at the Queen's Surf. Bill Robinson, the USVA's regional representative, presented the trophies. Tom Arnott was recognized for his prowess as OCC champ in 1947. Cline Mann, OCC Club Captain, represented our club.
