## Outrigger Golfers compete at Kaneohe MCAS Course

Once again, through the efforts of your golf committee and the cooperation of the military, Outrigger golfers enjoyed a fine outing at a military course. On Friday, 27 October, 73 golfers (largest number ever) participated in the Club's Fall Golf Tournament.

Allan Peralta, his round featured by an eagle two on the 17th hole, distanced the field with a sparkling two under par 70 to take A Flight Low Gross honors.

Three golfers had 67s for Low Net: Peralta, F. W. Stone and Buster Chapman, with Chapman getting first place, in accordance with PGA rules, because Chapman's handicap was lower than Stone's. Peralta, of course, took low gross. It is Club policy not to award two scoring trophies to a single individual. This allowed Allan Starr and Bill Haxton to take second and third low gross and Stone and Mel Ward to win second and third low net.

Celeste Phipps fired a fine 85 to nose out Mrs. Ralph Maxfield, one of the military sponsors, for the Ladies' low gross title. Mrs. Dick Wilson was third. Kai Ostrem, of the Ostrem golfing family, took Ladies low net with a 67. Delta Helbig and Grace Sandberg were second and third respectively. Thirteen ladies participated.

Men's B Flight was as tight as the proverbial 14 collar on a 16 neck, with Ken Taylor and Sandy Sandberg shooting duplicate 84's on 16 handicaps to finish tied for both low gross and low net honors. Each took one of the first place trophies.

That left Dick Wilson and Tom Pokonowsky as second and third low gross winners, and Red Berglund and Bill Phipps second and third low net titlests.

C Flight, the Grab Bag; Bill Capp calls it the "Wild Bunch;" was a mixture of high handicappers and no handicappers. The no handicappers were scored on the Callaway system, under which each golfer develops his own handicap on that particular day's play. A standard form is used for scoring.

Three good scores took top low gross trophies: 83, 84 and 85 by Gary Anderson, Jack Carter and Terry Stoddard, respectively. Low net trophy, amid cries of "sand bag" because of his net 62, went to Rab Guild.

Ladies longest drive trophy went to Mrs. Ralph Maxfield, and Men's closest to the pin trophy was annexed by Outrigger's precision golfer, Bill Capp.

A total of 23 military sponsors participated in order to allow our Outrigger members to play the military course.

The weather was perfect, the course was in excellent shape and a great outing was enjoyed by all.
