

Results of Tennis Survey

Results of a recent tennis questionnaire, which was enclosed with a recent Club billing statement, showed that approximately one hundred and seventeen members, or about five percent of the adult membership are tennis players who would like to see the Club have its own tennis facilities.

From this group, over half (54%) self-ranked themselves as being better than average tournament players. Learners, novices and average players made up the remaining categories. Approximately three out of four respondents wanted to be on the Club's tennis roster; and they would play on an OCC facility year around on an average of twenty days per month.

Besides playing tennis and wanting to have an OCC tennis facility, half the respondents wanted also to have paddle tennis courts and a quarter of them wanted racquet ball facilities. Squash and handball each got a little better than ten percent each of the remaining reaction.

Other activities which the respondents would like to see are more interclub tournaments, playing round-robin doubles matches and having tennis exchanges with other tennis organizations on the island.
