Youth Coach Mike Lum's Junior 'Riggers won seven of the 14 age-group events in the Clement D. Paiaina Regatta to open the 2014 Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association regatta season. The keiki also added points for one second, four third places, a fourth and a fifth.

Lum has grown the OCC youth paddling program to one of the best in the state over the past four years and Canoe Racing Chair Keahi Pelayo expects a banner season from the Junior 'Riggers.

OCC accumulated 151 points in the Paiaina Regatta on June 1, placing third behind Kailua (187) and Hui Nalu (160).

While the kids dominated the morning, the Masters men and women had a sterling late afternoon with the Men 60 winning their race. The masters also had four second places and three thirds and a fifth, seventh and eighth place.

The novices also contributed points for two thirds, a fourth and a seventh.

On June 8, OCC paddled in the Kamehameha Day Regatta at Kailua Beach Park, finishing in fourth place with 142 points. Again the Keiki and the Masters had a great day, as did the novice paddlers.

This was followed by a third place finish in the Father's Day Regatta on June 15. The Club also paddled in the Waimanalo Regatta on June 22.

After the first three regattas, Outrigger has three undefeated crews. Congratulations to the Boys 15 and 18, and the Masters Men 60. Another crew, the Girls 14, won two races, but hulied at the third, the Kamehameha Regatta after leading the race the whole way. 
