Paddlers Race On in Regatta Season



Outrigger Canoe Club's paddlers enter the second half of the Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association Regatta season by hosting the 60th annual Walter J. Macfarlane Regatta on the 4th of July at Waikiki Beach.

It promises to be a day of waves, fun in the sun and thrills as steersmen rule the day in the only wave race of the OHCRA season. Please join us for this very special canoe racing event.

Outrigger got a great start to the OHCRA season with a second place finish at the Clement Paaina Regatta at Keehi Lagoon. OCC led the AAA standings after the first 29 events by 18 points, but a lack of paddlers in the masters and novice division forced the Club to scratch eight events, giving the regatta victory to Lanikai, 96 to 79.

After the race, Canoe Racing Chair Kulani Jones noted that the new athletic memberships had helped fill some empty spots on the crew list. However, he put out a call to members urging them to join the program to help fill seats in the masters and novice boats.

Coach Mike Lum's Junior 'Riggers had a sensational start to their season, winning five races, finishing second in five, third in one and fourth in two giving the Club 44 points to start the day. It was the best start in many years.

Open coaches Steve Scott and Shelley Oates-Wilding brought home six second places, two thirds and two fourths, for a total of 24 points in the men's and women's open events.

In the second regatta, the Kamehameha Regatta on June 10 at Kailua Beach Park, Outrigger finished in third place, behind Lanikai and Kailua. The results of the June 17 Leeward Regatta and the June 24 Waimanalo Regatta will be in the magazine next month.

Paddlers will participate in the John D. Kaupiko Regatta on July 15 at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, the OHCRA Championships on July 22 at Keehi Lagoon, and the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association State Championships on Saturday, August 4 at Keehi Lagoon.




