



Winning the first race of the regatta for Outrigger were the Girls 14s, who are greeted with a victory tunnel.

*Summer officially arrives* for Outrigger Canoe Club members on the first Sunday of June every year when the Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association Regatta season opens. This year's Clement D. Paia Regatta on June 1, brought hundreds of members to Keehi Lagoon for the 37-event regatta, which features races for paddlers from age 12 to 55+.

Lanikai won the opening regatta with 73 points, followed closely by Hui Lanakila with 71, Kailua with 67 and Outrigger with 48.

Outrigger's Girls 14s won the first race of the day for OCC in their quarter-mile race, followed by wins from the Girls 16s and 18s, the Boys 18s, and the Masters Men 50.

Second place finishes were earned by the Boys 12 and 16, and the Masters Women 40 and 55. Third places went to the Sophomore, Senior and Masters 50 men.

A change in OHCR rules this year raised the ages for the Masters divisions. The old Junior Masters (formerly 35+) has now been raised to 40+. The Senior Masters (formerly 45+) is now 50+. The Golden Masters Division remains at 55+.

On June 8, paddlers headed to Kailua Beach Park for the Kamehameha Regatta. On June 15, the Leeward Regatta was held at Nanakuli Beach Park, and on June 22, paddlers headed to Waimanalo for the Waimanalo Regatta.

A total of 16 canoe clubs are competing in the OHCR races this year, making Hawaii's state sport of canoe racing the most participated in family sport with more than 3,000 participants each week.

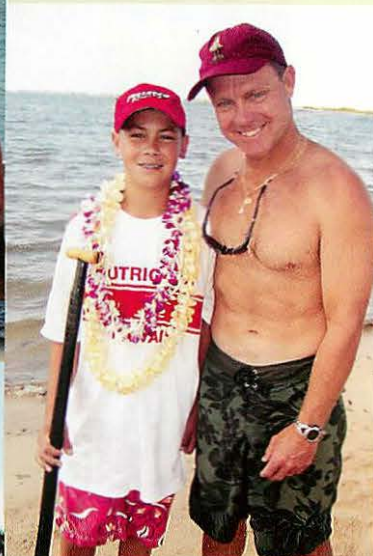
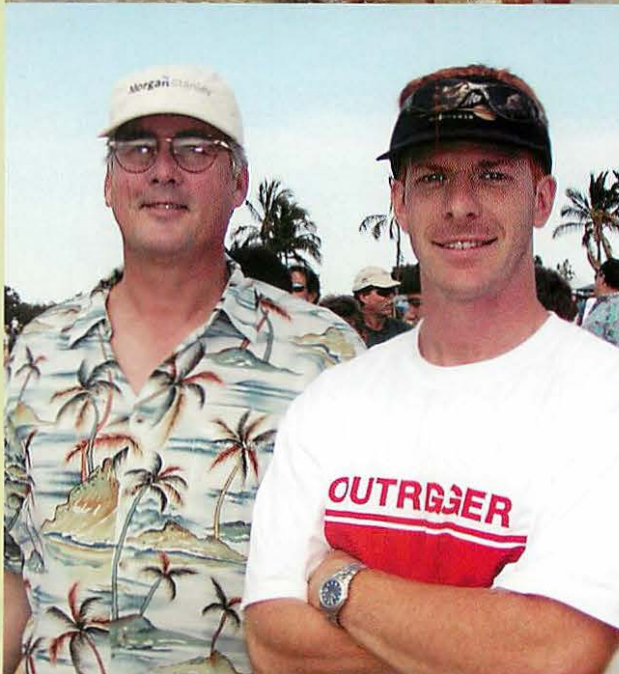
