

Outrigger Wins Leeward Kai Regatta, Second in Kamehameha, Waimanalo Races

Outrigger Canoe Club paddlers narrowly won the Leeward Kai Regatta at Nanakuli Beach on June 21, but finished second in the Kamehameha Regatta at Kailua on June 14 and Waimanalo Regatta on June 28 at Waimanalo.

In the Leeward Kai Regatta, Outrigger scored 63 points to runnerup Hui Nalu's 62 and Kailua's 47.

Kailua scored 77 points in their Kamehameha Regatta with OCC tallying 66 points and Hui Nalu third with 50 points. At Waimanalo, Kailua won the Masters Men's race to push OCC out of the lead. Kailua scored 60 points to Outrigger's 57. Lanikai was third with 53 points.

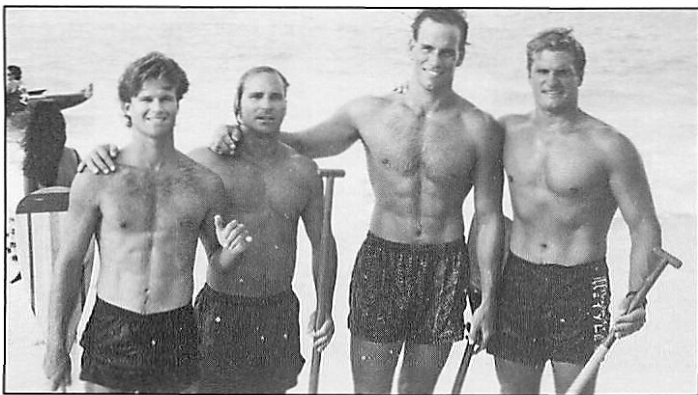

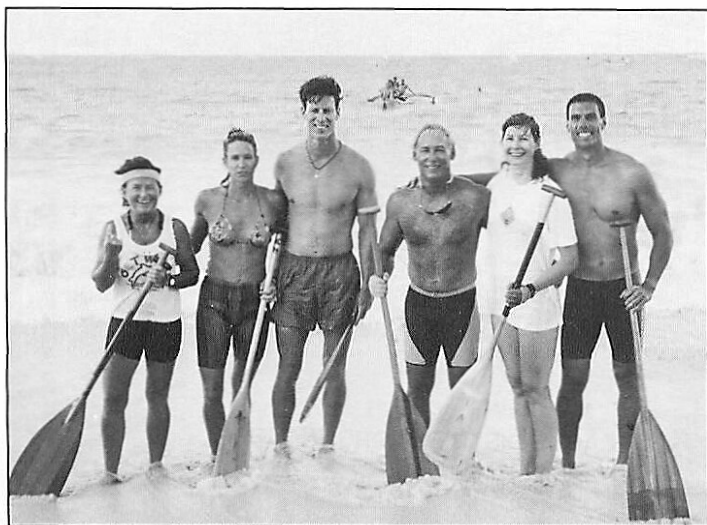
