

'Castle Swim' Revival Is Announced By Outrigger Club

The Thanksgiving Day "Castle Swim," last sponsored by the Outrigger Canoe Club about 20 years ago, is being revived this year under the chairmanship of A. E. (Toots) Minvielle Jr.

Mr. Minvielle, who won the men's race four times in the races that were first held in 1917, said entries for the swims will be received until November 25 at the Outrigger Canoe Club.

There will be a mile-and-a-third men's open race; another such race for Outrigger members; a three-quarter mile women's open race; another for Outrigger members and some races for Outrigger boys and girls.

He said there will be boys and girls open races also if enough interest is shown.

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be given first, second and third place winners, respectively. The races will begin at 10 a.m.

The course finish will be in front of the Outrigger Club.
