

# Swim Races Revival Set November 26

Revival of swimming races in waters off Waikiki Beach has been announced by Toots Minvielle, chairman for the sponsoring Outrigger Canoe Club.

November 26 (Thanksgiving Day) has been set for the "come-back" of the one time popular water events.

Minvielle and his committee have planned six races for the opening show, which is scheduled to start at 10 a.m.

He said there will be open races for both men and women, then open races for men and women members of the Outrigger Canoe Club, a race for girls under 17 and another for boys under 17.

"If entries warrant it, we'd run more races," said Minvielle.

Gold and bronze medals are to be awarded to winners in each of the events.

"Years ago these races were the most popular held on the beach," recalls Minvielle. "We hope to stir up the same spirit and interest."

Mr. Minvielle believes the last races of this kind were held in the mid-1930s.
